FINISHED SIZES:

Fits sizes 0-3 mos., 6-9 mos.
and 12-18 mos.

MATERIALS:

- Baby Fingering yarn:
 - 2 oz. each of lt. pink and white (for 0-3 mos.)
 - 2½ oz. each of lt. pink and white (for 6-9 mos.)
 - 3 oz. each of lt. pink and white (for 12-18 mos.)
- Tapestry needle
- E crochet hook and J double-ended hook or hook sizes needed to obtain gauges

GAUGES:

We are not responsible for lack of materials due to project not being worked to gauge. Gauges for this pattern: **E hook**, 4 clusters and 3 ch-1 sps = 1"; 4 rows = 1". **J double-ended hook**, 9 sts = 2"; 11 rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

To **draw up a lp**, insert hook in designated lp, bar or st, yo, draw lp through, leaving lp on hook.

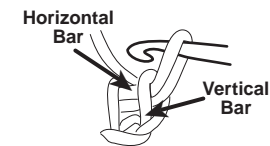
When picking up lps, leave all lps on hook unless otherwise stated.

To **turn**, rotate hook 180 degrees and slide all lps to opposite end. **Do not turn** unless otherwise stated.

To **work lps off hook when adding a new color**, with new color, place slip knot on hook,

draw slip knot through one lp on hook, (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) across.

Last lp remaining on hook at end of row is first **vertical bar** (see illustration) of next row.



To **work lps off hook with a color already in use**, pick up color from row below, yo, draw through one lp on hook, (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) across.

To **end a color that is no longer needed**, work across the row as stated and cut yarn leaving a long end; secure the end temporarily by tying to an adjacent yarn end, or permanently by weaving back through as inch or so on the row before.

To **sl st in a vertical bar**, insert hook under specified vertical bar, yo, draw through bar and lp on hook.

SACQUE

NOTES: Read General Instructions before beginning pattern.

Use J double-ended hook throughout unless otherwise stated.

Instructions are for size 0-3 mos.; sizes 6-9 mos. and 12-18 mos. are in [].

Bodice

Row 1: For front, with white, ch 32 [36, 40], draw up lp in second ch from hook, draw up lp in each

ch across, turn. (32 lps on hook)
[36 lps on hook; 40 lps on hook]

Row 2: With pink, work lps off hook, **do not turn.**

Row 3: Skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in each vertical bar across, turn.

Row 4: With white, work lps off hook, **do not turn.**

Row 5: Skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in each vertical bar across, turn.

Rows 6-70 [6-78, 6-86]: Repeat rows 2-5 consecutively, ending with row 2.

Row 71 [79, 87]: For **sleeve**, skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in next 10 [12, 14] vertical bars leaving remaining 21 [23, 25] vertical bars unworked; ch 11 [13, 15] loosely, drop lp from hook, insert hook in **top lp** of each ch just made, pick up dropped lp, turn. (22 lps on hook) [26 lps on hook; 30 lps on hook]

Rows 72-73 [80-81, 88-89]: Repeat rows 4 and 5.

Rows 74-150 [82-158, 90-166]: Repeat rows 2-5 consecutively, ending with row 2.

Row 151 [159, 167]: For **back**, skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in next 10 [12, 14] vertical bars; leaving remaining vertical bars unworked across sleeve, draw up lp in next 21 [23, 25] unworked vertical bars on row 70 [78, 86] of front, turn. (32 lps on hook) [36 lps on hook; 40 lps on hook]

Rows 152-153 [160-161, 168-169]: Repeat rows 4 and 5.

Rows 154-290 [162-314, 170-338]: Repeat rows 2-5 consecutively, ending with row 2.

Rows 291-370 [315-394, 339-418]: Repeat rows 71-150 [79-158; 87-166].

Row 371 [395, 419]: For **front**, skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in next 10 [12, 14] vertical bars; leaving remaining vertical bars unworked across sleeve, draw up lp in next 21 [23, 25] unworked vertical bars on row 290 [314, 338] of back, turn. (32 lps on hook) [36 lps on hook; 40 lps on hook]

Rows 372-373 [396-397, 420-421]: Repeat rows 4 and 5.

Rows 374-438 [398-470, 422-502]: Repeat rows 2-5 consecutively, ending with row 2.

Row 439 [471, 503]: Skip first vertical bar, sl st in each vertical bar across. Fasten off pink, cut and secure white.

With pink, sew Sleeve edges together.

Yoke

Note: Turn piece so that the dark side is facing you.

Row 1: Working in ends of rows across neckline, with E hook, join white with sc in end of first row, sc in same row, (skip next 3 rows, hdc in next row) across to last 2 rows, skip next row, sc in last row, turn. (112 sts made) [120 sts made; 128 sts made]

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, (ch 1, hdc next 2 sts tog) across to last st, ch 1, sc in last st, turn. (57 sts, 56 ch sps) [61 sts, 60 ch sps; 65 sts, 64 ch sps]

Rows 3-6 [3-8, 3-10]: Ch 1, sc in first st; (for **cluster, yo, insert hook in next ch sp, yo, pull**

through, yo, insert hook in same ch sp, yo, pull through, yo, pull through all lps on hook; ch 1) across, sc in last st, turn. (2 sc, 56 ch sps) [2 sc, 60 ch sps; 2 sc, 64 ch sps]

Row 7 [9, 11]: Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in each ch sp across, sc in last st, turn. (58 sts) [62 sts; 66 sts]

Row 8 [10, 12]: Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in each st across to last st, sc in last st, **do not turn.**

Row 9 [11, 13]: For **tie**, ch 40, sl st in second ch from hook, sl st in each ch across (sl st, ch 2, dc) in first st, *skip next st, (sl st, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * across to last st, sl st in last st; for **tie**, ch 40, sl st in second ch from hook, sl st in each ch across, sl st in next sl st. Fasten off.

CAP Brim

Row 1: With white, ch 22 [26, 30], draw up lp in second ch from hook, draw up lp in each ch across, turn. (22 lps on hook) [26 lps on hook; 30 lps on hook]

Row 2: With pink, work lps off hook, **do not turn.**

Row 3: Skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in each vertical bar across, turn.

Row 4: With white, work lps off hook, **do not turn.**

Row 5: Skip first vertical bar, draw up lp in each vertical bar across, turn.

Rows 6-120 [6-132, 6-144]: Repeat rows 2-5 consecutively, ending with row 4.

Row 121 [133, 145]: Skip first vertical bar, sl st in each vertical bar across, cut and secure pink, **do not turn**, fasten off white.

Crown

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, with dark side facing you, with E hook, ch 1, hdc in first row, (skip next 3 rows, hdc in next row) across, turn. (31 hdc made) [34 hdc made; 37 hdc made]

Row 2: For **0-3 mos. and 12-18 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (cluster in next st, ch 1, skip next st) 14 [17] times, cluster in next st, ch 1, hdc in last st, turn. (17 sts, 15 ch sps) [20 sts, 18 ch sps]

Row 2: For **6-9 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (cluster in next st, ch 1, skip next st) 16 times, hdc in last st, turn. [18 sts, 16 ch sps]

Rows 3-5 [3-7]: For **0-3 mos. and 12-18 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (cluster in next ch sp, ch 1) across, hdc in last st, turn.

Rows 3-6: For **6-9 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (cluster in next ch sp, ch 1, skip next st) across, hdc in last st, turn.

Row 6: For **0-3 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (hdc next 2 ch sps tog, ch 1) across, hdc in last st, turn. (9 sts, 6 ch sps)

Row 7: For **0-3 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, ch 1, (hdc next 2 ch sps tog, ch 1) across, hdc in last st, turn. *(5 sts, 4 ch sps)*

Rows [7,8]: For **6-9 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (hdc next 2 ch sps tog, ch 1) across, hdc in last st, turn. *[10 sts, 8 ch sps; 6 sts, 4 ch sps]*

Row 8 [9]: For **0-3 mos. and 6-9 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (hdc next 2 ch sps tog) 2 times, hdc in last st. Fasten off. *(4 sts) [4 sts]*

Row [8]: For **12-18 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (hdc next 2 chs tog, ch 1) 8 times, hdc next 2 ch sps tog, hdc in last st, turn. *[11 sts, 8 ch sps]*

Row [9]: For **12-18 mos. only**, ch 1, hdc in first st, (ch 1, hdc next 2 ch sps tog) across, hdc in last st, turn. *[6 sts, 4 ch sps]*

Row [10]: For **12-18 mos. only** ch 1, hdc in first st, (hdc next 2 ch sp tog) 2 times, hdc in last st. Fasten off. *[4 sts]*

Trim

NOTE: To **join with hdc**, place slip knot on hook, yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through, yo,

pull through all lps on hook.

Row 1: With dark side facing you, working in sts across Brim and Crown and in ends of rows, join white with hdc (*see Note*) in first st on Brim, (skip next st or next row, hdc in next st or row) 30 [35, 40] times, skip next 2 sts, hdc in last st turn. *(32 hdc made) [37 hdc, 42 hdc made]*

Rows 2-3 [2-4, 2-5]: Ch 1, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 4 [5, 6]: For **tie**, ch 50, sl st in second ch from hook, sl st in each ch across, sc in first st, sc in each st across; for **tie**, ch 50, sl st in second ch from hook, sl st in each ch across, sl st in next st. Fasten off.
