Official Rules

Bear & Blanket

BEAR

FINISHED SIZE

16" tall in a sitting position

MATERIALS

- □ 6 oz. Cafe Au Lait #9334 (tan) Red Heart[®] Light & Lofty[™] Art. E708 by Coats & Clark or bulky yarn
- □ Small amount Coffee #365 (brown) Red Heart[®] Classic[™] Art. E267 by Coats & Clark or worsted yarn

□ Optional for Ball: 3 oz. Cloud #9311 (white) Red Heart[®] Baby Clouds[™] Art. E710 by Coats & Clark

- Polyester fiberfill
- Tapestry needle
- G and L hooks or hook sizes needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE

G hook and worsted yarn, Nose is $1\frac{1}{2}$ " across.

L hook and bulky yarn, 2 sc = 1"; 2 sc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc

NOTES

Do not join rnds unless otherwise stated. Mark first st of each rnd. Use L hook and tan bulky yarn unless otherwise stated.

BALL (optional)

NOTE: The Ball is used when blanket is not inside animal to help hold animal's shape.

Rnd 1: With white, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, do not join. (8 sc made) Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around. (16)

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) around. (24)

Rnd 4: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) around. (32)

- **Rnd 5:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) around. (40)
- **Rnd 6:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) around. *(48)*
- **Rnds 7–14:** Sc in each st around.
- **Rnd 15:** (Sc in next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (40)
- **Rnd 16:** (Sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (32)
- **Rnd 17:** (Sc in next 2 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. *(24)*
- **Rnd 18:** (Sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog) around. Stuff. (16)
- **Rnd 19:** (Sc next 2 sts tog) around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Sew opening closed.

BEAR

Head

- Rnd 1: Starting at top, with tan, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, **do not join.** (8 sc made)
- **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (16)
- **Rnd 3:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) around. (24)
- Rnd 4: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) around. (32)
- **Rnds 5–6:** Sc in each st around.
- **Rnd 7:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) around. (40)
- **Rnds 8–12:** Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 13: (Sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (32)
- Rnd 14: (Sc in next 2 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (24)
- **Rnd 15:** Working this rnd in **back Ips** only, (sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog) around. Stuff. (16).
- Rnd 16: (Sc next 2 sts tog) around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. (8)
- Sew opening closed.

Body

- **Rnd 1:** Working in **front lps** of rnd 14 on Head, join tan with sc in first st, sc in each st around, **do not join.** (24 sc made)
- Rnd 2: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 3: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) around. (32)
- **Rnd 4:** Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 5: (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) around. (40)
- **Rnd 6:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) around. (48)
- **Rnd 7:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts) around. (56)
- Rnd 8: Sc in each st around.
- **Rnd 9:** Ch 20, skip next 20 sts, sc in each st around. (36 sc, 20 chs)
- **Rnd 10:** Sc in each ch and in each st around.
- Rnds 11–16: Sc in each st around.
- **Rnd 17:** Working this rnd in **back Ips** only, sc in each st around.
- **Rnd 18:** Working in **both lps**, sc in each st around.
- Rnd 19: (Sc in next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (48)
- Rnd 20: (Sc in next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (40)
- Rnd 21: (Sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (32)

- Rnd 22: (Sc in next 2 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (24)
- Rnd 23: (Sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog) around. (16)
- Rnd 24: (Sc next 2 sts tog) around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. (8) Sew last rnd closed.

Flap

- **Row 1:** Working in skipped sts of rnd 8 on Body, join tan with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn. (20 sc made)
- Rows 2–9: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Leg (make 2)

- Rnd 1: With tan, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, **do not join.** (8 sc made)
- **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (16) **Rnd 3:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) around. (24)
- **Rnd 4:** Working this rnd in **back Ips** only, sc in each st around.
- Rnd 5: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 6: (Sc next 2 sts tog) 8 times, sc in each st around. (16)
- **Rnds 7–16:** Sc in each st around. At end of last rnd, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.
- Stuff lower two-thirds of Leq.
- Flatten last rnd and sew opening closed.
- Sew Legs to front lps of rnd 16 on bottom of Body 5" apart.

Arm (make 2)

- **Rnd 1:** With tan, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 7 sc in ring, **do not join.** (7 sc made)
- **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (14) Rnd 3: 2 sc in next st, sc in each st around. (15)
- Rnds 4–15: Sc in each st around. At end of last rnd, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.
- Stuff lower two-thirds of Arm.
- Flatten last rnd and sew Arms to each side of Body over rnd 4.

Muzzle

Rnd 1: With tan, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, **do not join.** (8 sc made) **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around. (16)

- Rnd 3: (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) around. (24)
- **Rnds 4–5:** Sc in each st around. At end of last rnd, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.
- Sew to front of Head, stuffing before closing.

Ear (make 2)

- Row 1: With tan, ch 2, 3 sc in second ch from hook, turn. (3) sc made)
- **Row 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st across, turn. (6)
- Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) across. Fasten off. (9)
- Sew Ears over rnds 4–6 on each side of Head.

Eye (make 2)

- With G hook and brown worsted, ch 3, yo, insert hook in third ch from hook, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook, (yo, insert hook in same ch, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook) 3 times, yo, pull through all lps on hook leaving long end for sewing. Fasten off. Weave long end through top of
- sts, pull to shape round button. Sew to Head above Muzzle 3/4" apart.

Nose

- **Rnd 1:** With G hook and brown worsted, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, **do not join.** (8 sc made)
- **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. (16)
- Sew to top of Muzzle as shown in photo.
- With tapestry needle and two strands brown worsted, using straight stitches (see illustration) embroider mouth lines as shown in photo.

BLANKET

FINISHED SIZE

31¹/₂" square

MATERIALS

- □ 12 oz. Cloud #9311 (white) Red Heart[®] Baby Clouds[™] Art. E710 by Coats & Clark or bulky yarn
- □ 6 oz. Ćafe Au Lait #9334 (tan) Red Heart® Light & Lofty™ Art. E708 by Coats & Clark or bulky yarn
- □ Red Heart[®] Kids[™] Årt. E711 by Coats & Clark or worsted yarn:
 - 3 oz. Blue #2845,
 - 3 oz. Turquoise #2850
 - 3 oz. Lime #2652
 - 3 oz. Green #2677
- N hook or hook size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE

Bulky yarn, 5 dc = 3"; 3 dc rows = 3¹/₂".

BASIC STITCHES

Ch, sl st, sc, dc

BLANKET

- **Row 1:** With white, ch 52, dc in fourth ch from hook, dc in each ch across, turn. *(50 dc made)*
- **Rows 2–3:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.
- **Row 4:** With one strand each green and lime held together as one, join with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.
- **Row 5:** Join tan with sl st in first st, ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.
- **Row 6:** With one strand each green and lime held together as one, join with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.
- **Row 7:** Join white with sl st in first st, ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.
- **Rows 8–9:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.
- **Row 10:** With one strand each blue and turquoise held together as one, join with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.
- **Row 11:** Join tan with sl st in first

st, ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

- **Row 12:** With one strand each blue and turquoise held together as one, join with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.
- **Row 13:** Join white with sl st in first st, ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.
- **Rows 14–33:** Repeat rows 2-13 consecutively, ending with row 9.

Border

- **Rnd 1:** Working around outer edge, with one strand each green and lime held together as one, join with sc in any corner, 2 sc in same st, sc in each st and 2 sc in end of each row around with 3 sc in each corner, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.
- **Rnd 2:** With one strand each blue and turquoise held together as one, join with sc in any center corner st, 2 sc in same st, sc in each st around with 3 sc in each center corner st, join. Fasten off.

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
