Size

Engine: 12 1/2" long
Engineer: 8" tall

Pattern Notes

Cut additional plastic canvas pieces not graphed as listed below:

Boiler Front & Back (optional): Cut outer 5 rounds from 2 (4 1/4") radial circles. Use center circles.

Small Wheels (optional): Cut outer 2 rounds from 2 (3") radial circles. Use center circles.

Boiler: Cut 60 x 38 holes.

Smoke Stack: Cut 34 x 9 holes.

Bell Holder: Cut 2 (50 x 3 holes).

Cab Roof: Cut 30 x 24 holes.

Base Top & Bottom: Cut 2 (66 x 26 holes).

Base Sides: Cut 2 (66 x 8 holes).

Base Ends: Cut 2 (26 x 8 holes).

Engine

Boiler Front

Rnd 1 (RS): With white yarn, ch 2, 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (10 sc)

Rnd 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around. (15 sc)

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next sc, sc in each

of next 2 sc] rep around. (20 sc)
Rnd 4: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around, sl st in next st, fasten off. (30 sc)

Rnd 5: Attach Olympic blue yarn in any sc, ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, fasten off. (30 sc)

Nose

Rnd 1: With white yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (5 sc)

Rnd 2: Sc in each of next 5 sc, join in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off. (5 sc)

With yarn needle and rem length of yarn, weave through sts of Rnd 2; pull gently to close. Sew to Rnd 1 of front.

Mouth

With RS facing, working between Rnds 3 and 4 centered below nose, holding jockey red yarn on WS and working across 5 center sts, insert hook, draw up a lp, [insert hook in next st, draw up a lp and draw through st on hook] rep until 5 sl sts centered below nose are completed, fasten off. Draw yarn end to WS and secure.

Eyelashes (make 2)

Separate 1 yd of black yarn into 2 plies. With 2 plies of black yarn and steel crochet hook size 7, ch 8 (beg ch), sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in each of next 2 chs, [ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in each of next 2 chs, sl st in next ch of beg ch] 4 times, leaving a rem length of yarn, fasten off.

With yarn needle and rem length of yarn, sew eyelashes evenly sp above nose. Lightly apply blush-er to nose and cheeks.

Boiler Back

Rnds 1–5: With Olympic blue yarn, rep Rnds 1–5 of front. (30 sc)

Boiler Body

Rnd 1: With face of front facing and

working around back posts of each sc of Rnd 5, attach Olympic blue yarn, ch 1, bpsc around each st around, join in beg bpsc, turn. (30 bpsc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of next 30 sc, join in beg sc, turn.

Rnds 3–25: Rep Rnd 2.

At the end of Rnd 25, fasten off.

Boiler Trim

Note: Boiler trim is worked between Rnds 9 and 10, Rnds 15 and 16, and Rnds 21 and 22 of boiler body.

Rnd 1: Holding jockey red yarn inside boiler body at indicated rnd, insert hook, draw up a lp, [insert hook in next st, draw up a lp and loosely draw through st on hook] rep around, fasten off, secure ends on inside of boiler.

Boiler Assembly

With yarn needle and length of Olympic blue, Whipstitch short sides of plastic canvas boiler body tog to form a tube. Whipstitch plastic canvas boiler front to 1 end of tube. Stuff firmly with fiberfill; Whipstitch plastic canvas back to other end of tube. Slide assembled plastic canvas boiler



into crocheted boiler. Sew crocheted boiler back in place.

Smokestack

Outer edge

Note: Whipstitch short edges of plastic canvas smokestack piece together to form tube.

Rnd 1: With Olympic blue yarn, ch 20, join to form a ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around, join in beg sc, turn. (20 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, turn.

Rnds 3–5: Rep Rnd 2.

Inner edge

Rnd 6: Working in back lps only, ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc, turn.

Rnds 7–10: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 11: Insert crocheted piece over plastic canvas smokestack, working in Rnd 10 and opposite side of foundation ch, sl st around, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Rnd 12: Attach Olympic blue yarn in rem free lp of Rnd 5, ch 1, reverse sc in each st around, join, fasten off.

Sew smokestack to top of boiler at center front.

Bell Holder

Row 1: With Olympic blue yarn, ch 29, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (28 sc)

Rows 2–4: Ch 1, sc in each of next 28 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 4, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Whipstitch 2 plastic canvas bell holder pieces tog on top of 1 another. Sew crocheted bell holder over plastic canvas. Using photo as a guide, sew liberty bell at center of holder. Sew each end to boiler over Rnds 17 and 18, with bell 1/4" above boiler.

Cab Outer Front & Sides

Note: Whipstitch plastic canvas cab sides to cab front.

Row 1 (RS): With Olympic blue yarn, ch 35, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (34 sc)

Rows 2–10: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Right edge of cab

Row 11 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn. (3 sc)

Rows 12–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Center front of cab

Row 11 (RS): Sk next 5 sc of Row 10, attach Olympic blue yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 17 sc, turn. (18 sc)

Rows 12 & 13: Ch 1, sc in each of next 18 sc, turn.

Center front left edge

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn.

Rows 15–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Center front right edge

Row 14 (WS): Sk 8 sc for center front window opening, attach Olympic blue in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 4 sc, turn. (5 sc)

Rows 15–18: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Left edge of cab

Row 11 (RS): Sk next 5 sc of Row 10, attach Olympic blue yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Rows 12–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Row 19 (RS): Attach Olympic blue yarn in first st at top right edge of Row 18, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 2 sc, ch 5 (right-side window), sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 8 (center-front window), sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 5 (left-side window), sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each sc and each ch across, turn. (34 sc)

Row 21: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 22: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 12 sc, ch 1, sc in each of next

10 sc, leave rem 12 sc unworked, turn. (10 sc)

Row 23: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 3 sc, ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc, sl st in same st as last sc, fasten off. (4 sc)

Sew crocheted piece to plastic canvas cab around entire outer edge; sew around each window opening.

Cab Inner Sides

Make 2

Row 1 (RS): With Olympic blue yarn, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (9 sc)

Rows 2–10: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Right edge

Row 11 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 12–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Left edge

Row 11 (RS): Sk next 5 sc of Row 10, attach Olympic blue yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 12–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Row 19 (RS): Attach Olympic blue yarn at right edge in first sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, ch 5 (window opening), sc in each of next 2 sc of left edge, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 chs, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Row 21: Ch 1, sc in each of next 9 sc, fasten off.

With yarn needle, sew each inner side to inside of cab around entire outer edge and around window opening.

Cab Inner Front

Row 1 (RS): With Olympic blue yarn, ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (12 sc)

Rows 2–13: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Right edge

Row 14 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 15–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Left edge

Row 14 (WS): Sk next 8 sc of Row 13, attach Olympic blue yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 15–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Row 19: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, ch 8 (window opening), sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of next 8 chs, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (12 sc)

Row 21: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 22: Ch 1, sl st in next sc, ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc, leaving last sc unworked, turn.

Row 23: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 3 sc, ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc, sl st in same st as last sc, fasten off. Set aside.

With yarn needle and length of Olympic blue yarn, center back of boiler to center front bottom of cab. Making sure face on boiler is in the upright position, sew to boiler. Sew inner cab section to inside edge around entire outer edge and around window opening.

Cab Top Back

Row 1 (RS): With Olympic blue yarn, ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (12 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sl st in first sc, ch 1, sc in each of next 10 sc, leaving last sc unworked, turn. (10 sc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sl st in each of next 3 sc, ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc, fasten off.

Row 5 (RS): Attach Olympic blue yarn in opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (12 sc)

Rows 6–8: Rep Rows 2–4.

At the end of Row 8, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

With yarn needle and rem length of yarn, sew crocheted section over plastic canvas cab top piece. Sew to top back of cab.

Cab Roof

Rnd 1 (RS): With Olympic blue yarn, ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 15 chs, working on opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each of next 16 chs. (32 sc)

Rnds 2–12: Sc in each sc around.

At the end of Rnd 12, join in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Insert plastic canvas roof. With yarn needle and rem length of yarn, Whipstitch across outer back edge of crocheted piece, sewing through plastic canvas across edge. Sew roof to top of cab.

Base

Top

Row 1: With Olympic blue yarn, ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (12 sc)

Rows 2–38: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 38, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Sew to plastic canvas base top around entire outer edge.

Bottom

Rows 1–38: Rep Rows 1–38 of top. Sew to plastic canvas base bottom around entire outer edge.

End pieces (make 2)

Row 1: With Olympic blue yarn, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (4 sc)

Rows 2–12: Ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 12, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Sew to plastic canvas end piece around entire outer edge.

Side pieces (make 2)

Row 1: Rep Row 1 of end piece. (4 sc)

Rows 2–38: Ch 1, sc in 4 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 38, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Sew to plastic canvas side piece around entire outer edge.

With yarn needle and length of Olympic blue yarn, sew top of base to bottom of cab and boiler. Sew base ends and sides to top of base. Set bottom aside; this will be attached later.

Cowcatcher

First half

Row 1 (WS): With nickel yarn, ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (16 sc)

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each of next 6 sts, [dec 1 sc over next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of next 6 sts, turn. (14 sc)

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each of next 5 sts, [dec 1 sc over next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of next 5 sts, turn. (12 sc)

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Row 7: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each of next 4 sts, [dec 1 sc over next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of next 4 sts, turn. (10 sc)

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each of next 3 sts, [dec 1 sc over next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of next 3 sts, fasten off.

Second half

Row 1 (WS): Attach nickel in opposite side of foundation ch of Row 1, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (16 sc)

Rows 2–9: Rep Rows 2–9 of first half.

At the end of Row 9, do not fasten off.

Row 10: With WS facing, working in ends of rows, ch 1, work 1 sc in each of Rows 9, 7, 5, 3 and 1, and 1 sc in center of foundation ch, continuing across edge, work 1 sc in each of Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9, fold Row 9 in half,

working through both thicknesses in top lps only, work 4 sl sts down edge, fasten off.

Turn piece around; rep Row 10 in opposite ends of rows and down edge.

Row 11: Insert plastic canvas cowcatcher, working through both thicknesses, attach nickel yarn in first sc worked along edges of rows, ch 1, sc in same st as beg ch-1, work 10 sc across edge, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Sew cowcatcher top (Row 11) and sides to front end piece.

Large Wheels

Note: Make 8 sections for 4 wheels; 2 are joined for each wheel.

Rnd 1 (RS): With black yarn, ch 2, 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc, draw a lp of nickel yarn through st on hook, drop black yarn to back of work. (10 sc)

Rnd 2: With nickel yarn, ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, draw up a lp of black yarn, drop nickel yarn to back of work. (10 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [fpdc around sc of Rnd 1 directly below, sc in next sc of Rnd 2] rep around, join in beg fpdc, draw up a lp of nickel yarn, drop black to back of work. (10 fpdc; 10 sc)

Rnd 4: With nickel yarn, ch 1, [sc in top of fpdc, working over black sc of Rnd 3, work 2 sc in nickel sc directly below in Rnd 2] rep around, join in top of beg sc, draw up a lp of black yarn, fasten off nickel yarn.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, [sc in each sc, fpdc around fpdc directly below] rep around, join in beg st, fasten off. (20 fpdc; 20 sc)

Rep Rnds 1–5 until 4 large wheels are completed. While working 5th–8th large wheels, at the end of Rnd 5, do not fasten off.

Rnd 6: Holding wrong sides of 2 large wheels tog, with plastic canvas sandwiched between, sl st in each st around, fasten off.

Sew first wheel at back edge of engine, centered, on side piece.

Sew 2nd large wheel next to previous wheel. Rep in same manner on opposite side of engine.

Small Wheels

Note: Make 4 sections for 2 wheels; 2 are joined for each wheel.

Rnds 1 & 2: Rep Rnds 1 and 2 of large wheels. (10 sc)

Rnd 3: With nickel yarn, ch 1, [draw up a lp in sc of Rnd 2, drop nickel yarn, with black yarn, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook, yo, insert hook front to back to front around sc directly below in Rnd 1, yo, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook, drop black yarn, with nickel yarn, yo, draw through rem 2 lps on hook (fpdc)] rep around to within last fpdc, complete last fpdc with black yarn, do not change to nickel yarn, join in beg sc, fasten off nickel yarn. (20 fpdc)

Rnd 4: With black yarn, ch 1, [sc in sc, sc in top of fpdc, fphdc around fpdc] rep around, join in beg sc, fasten off. (20 sc; 10 fphdc)

Rep Rnds 1–4 on next small wheel; on 3rd and 4th small wheels, do not fasten off at the end of Rnd 4.

Rnd 5: Holding wrong sides of 2 small wheels tog with plastic canvas sandwiched between, sl st in each st around, fasten off.

Sew a small wheel to each front side of engine, centered, on side piece.

Engine Right Hand

Fingers & thumb (make 4)

Rnd 1: With crochet hook size C and white yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (5 sc)

Rnds 2 & 3: Sc in each of next 5 sc. At the end of Rnd 3, sl st in next st, fasten off. On 4th piece (little finger), do not fasten off.

Hand & arm

Rnd 1: With little finger left on hook, pick up middle finger, sc in each of next 2 sc, pick up index finger, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in each of next 3 sk sc of middle

finger, sc in each of next 3 sc of little finger.

Rnd 2: Sc in each of next 15 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each of next 5 sc, pick up thumb, [insert hook from inside thumb through st and into next st of hand, draw up a lp, yo, draw through both lps on hook] twice, sc in each of next 8 sc.

(15 sc)

Rnd 4: Sc in each of next 5 sc, working in rem 3 sts of thumb only, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts of hand. (16 sc)

Rnd 5: Sc in each of next 2 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, [sc in each of next 4 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] twice. (13 sc)

Rnd 6: [Sc in next sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] 4 times, sc in next sc. (9 sc)

Rnd 7: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 8: [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 3 times. (12 sc)

Stuff thumb, fingers and hand lightly with fiberfill. Do not add any fiberfill beyond Rnd 8.

Rnds 9–18: Sc in each of next 12 sc.

At the end of Rnd 18, sl st in next st, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Engine Left Hand

Fingers & thumb (make 4)

Rep Rnds 1–3 of fingers and thumb of right hand.

Hand & arm

Rnd 1: With little finger left on hook, pick up middle finger, sc in each of next 3 sts, pick up index finger, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in each of next 2 sk sc of middle finger, sc in each of next 2 sc of little finger.

Rnd 2: Sc in each of next 15 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each of next 8 sc, pick up thumb, [insert hook from inside thumb through st and into next st of hand, draw up a lp, yo, draw through both lps on hook] twice, sc in each of next 5 sc.

(15 sts)

Rnd 4: Sc in each of next 8 sc of hand, working in next 3 rem sc of thumb only, sc in each of next

3 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc of hand. (16 sc)

Rnd 5: [Dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] twice, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc. (13 sc)

Rnd 6: [Sc in next sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] 4 times, sc in next sc. (9 sc)

Rnds 7–18: Rep Rnds 7–18 of right hand.

With yarn needle and rem length of yarn, secure Rnd 18 of each hand to base of boiler between of boiler and top of base. Posi-

tioning hands as desired, tack fingers in place.

With yarn needle and length of Olympic blue yarn, sew bottom of base to bottom of sides and ends, stuffing with fiberfill before closing.

Knuckle

Row 1 (RS): With Olympic blue yarn, ch 3, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, turn. (2 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (4 sc)

Rows 3–9: Ch 1, sc in each of next 4 sc, turn.

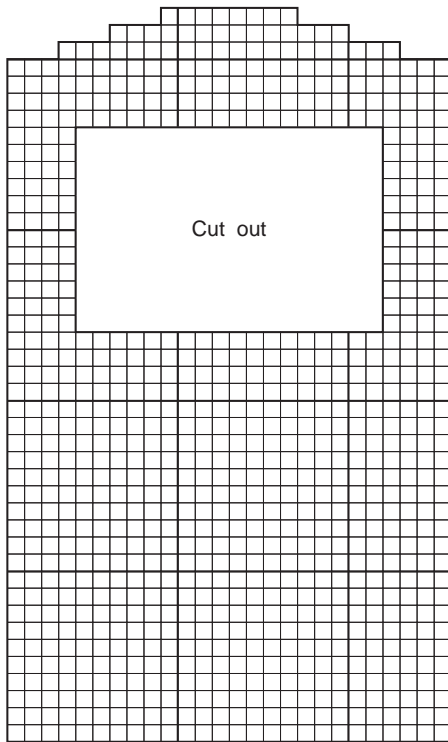
At the end of Row 9, fasten off.

Row 10 (RS): With opposite side of foundation facing, attach Olympic blue yarn in first ch, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, sc in next ch, turn. (2 sc)

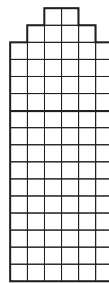
Rows 11–18: Rep Rows 2–9.

At the end of Row 18, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

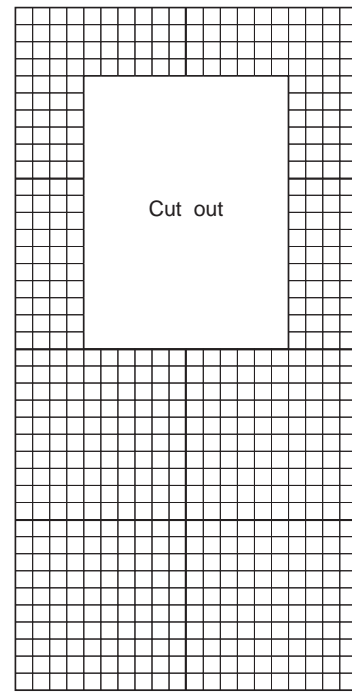
Sew crocheted piece over plastic canvas knuckle. Sew half of snap fastener to the rounded end centered over Row 2. With snap facing down, sew knuckle centered to back bottom base of engine.



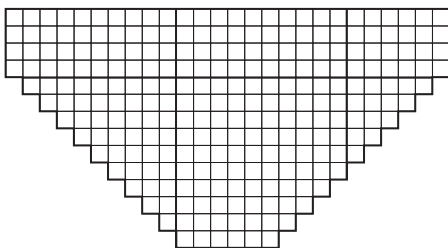
Engine Cab Front

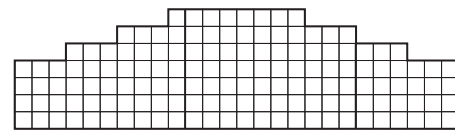
Knuckle

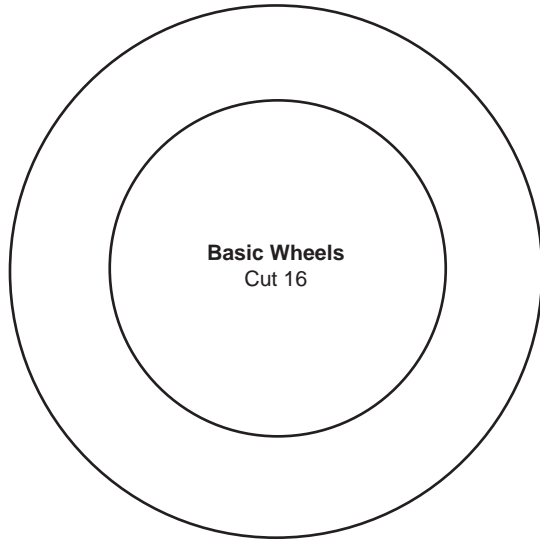


Engine Cow Catcher

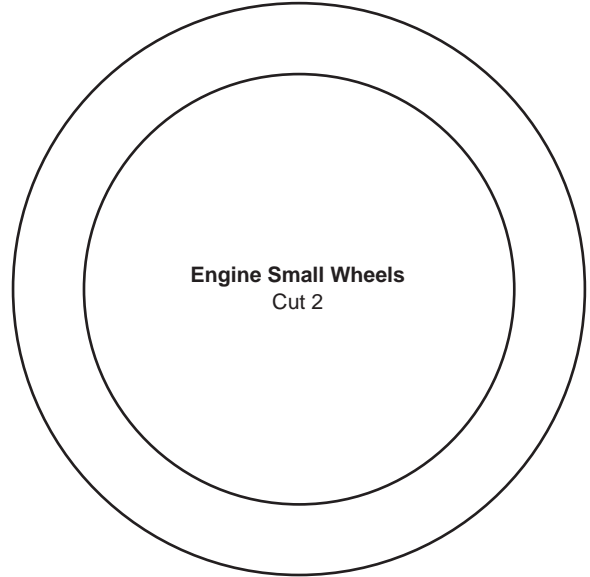


Engine Cab Top Back

Engineer

Nose

Rnd 1 (RS): With off-white yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (6 sc)
Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Head

Rnd 1 (RS): With off-white yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (5 sc)
Rnd 2: Ch 1, work 2 sc in each sc around, join in beg sc. (10 sc)
Rnd 3: Ch 1, [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around, join in beg sc. (15 sc)
Rnd 4: Ch 1, [sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around, join in beg sc, fasten off. (20 sc)
Rnd 5: Attach mid brown yarn in any sc, ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, draw up a lp, remove hook. (20 sc)

With yarn needle, thread rem length of yarn from nose. Weave yarn through sts of Rnd 2; pull to close; secure. Sew nose centered over Rnd 1 of head; secure at back; fasten off.

Eyes

Secure 12mm sew-on eyes to head.

Mouth

With yarn needle and length of jockey red yarn, sew a 1/4" straight st between Rnds 3 and 4, centered under nose; secure at back; fasten off.

Mustache

With yarn needle and length of mid

brown yarn, hold handle end of crochet hook size G under nose; sew several lps under nose over crochet hook to make all lps even, remove hook and secure yarn at back. Pick up dropped lp of Rnd 5.

Rnds 6–8: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc. (20 sc)
Rnd 9: Ch 1, [sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around, join in beg sc. (15 sc)
Rnd 10: Ch 1, [sc in next sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] rep around, join in beg sc. (10 sc)
Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Hair

With yarn needle and length of mid brown yarn, hold handle end of crochet hook size G over top of head. Working over Rnd 5 sts, beg at either side of head at point aligned with eyes, and working to other side of head, sew lps over crochet hook to make all lps even; secure yarn; remove hook.

Eyeglasses

Note: The following steps are to secure glasses so that a younger child cannot remove them.

Stuff head with fiberfill. Insert each side of temple of glasses into head at Rnd 5; bend ends slightly at back toward each other.

With yarn needle and length of mid brown yarn, secure temple ends tog.

With rem length of yarn from Rnd 11 of head, weave sts closed; secure; fasten off.

Hat

Note: Hat is crocheted with black and white yarn. At beg of row, pattern will indicate which color is being used. Simply drop yarn color not in use; do not fasten off until indicated.

Row 1: With black yarn, ch 10, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in each rem st across, turn. (9 sl sts)

Row 2: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each sl st across, turn.

Row 3: Rep Row 2.

Rows 4 & 5: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each sl st across, turn.

Rows 6 & 7: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Rows 8 & 9: Rep Rows 4 and 5.

Rows 10 & 11: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Row 12: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 9 sl sts, sl st in turning lp of previous row, turn. (10 sl sts)

Row 13: Rep Row 4.

Row 14: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 10 sl sts, sl st in turning lp of previous row, turn. (11 sl sts)

Row 15: Rep Row 2.

Row 16: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 11 sl sts, sl st in turning lp of previous row, turn. (12 sl sts)

Row 17: Rep Row 4.

Row 18: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 12 sl sts, sl st in turning lp of previous row, turn. (13 sl sts)

Row 19: Rep Row 2.

Row 20: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 13 sl sts, sl st in turning lp of previous row, turn. (14 sl sts)

Row 21: Rep Row 4.

Row 22: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 14 sl sts, sl st in turning lp of previous row, turn. (15 sl sts)

Row 23: Rep Row 2.

Rows 24 & 25: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 15 sl sts, turn.

Rows 26 & 27: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 15 sl sts, turn.

Rows 28–31: Rep Rows 24–27.

Row 32: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 14 sl sts, turn. (14 sl sts)

Row 33: Rep Row 4.

Row 34: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 13 sl sts, turn. (13 sl sts)

Row 35: Rep Row 2.

Row 36: With black yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 12 sl sts, turn. (12 sl sts)

Row 37: Rep Row 4.

Row 38: With white yarn, sl st in back lp of each of next 11 sl sts, turn. (11 sl sts)

Row 39: Rep Row 2.

Row 40: With black yarn, sl st in back lps of each of next 10 sl sts, turn. (10 sl sts)

Row 41: Rep Row 4.

Row 42: With white yarn, sl st in back lps of each of next 9 sl sts, turn. (9 sl sts)

Row 43: Rep Row 2.

Row 44: With black yarn, sl st in back lps of each of next 9 sl sts, turn.

Row 45: Rep Row 4.

Rows 46–49: Rep Rows 42–45.

At the end of Row 49, fasten off black yarn.

Rows 50 & 51: Rep Rows 42 and 43.

At the end of Row 51, leaving a length of white yarn, fasten off.

With yarn needle and rem length of white yarn, sew Row 51 to opposite side of foundation ch; knot to secure. Working in ends of rows at color change (back of hat), weave rem length through sts; pull to close; secure; fasten off.

With yarn needle and length of white yarn, working on inside

edge of hat at beg inc sts for visor, knot yarn to secure; catching back of sts only, weave needle across edge to point of 9 sl sts on opposite edge of visor, pull slightly to gather, secure yarn, fasten off. Place hat on head, tack in place around edge, do not stitch visor edge to head.

Body

Make 2

Rnd 1 (RS): With light periwinkle yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (5 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, join in beg sc. (10 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around, join in beg sc. (15 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, [sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around, join in beg sc. (20 sc)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, [sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 4 times, sc in each of next 2 sc, join in beg sc. (25 sc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, fasten off first body piece, do not fasten off 2nd body piece.

Rnd 7: Holding body sections tog, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st around, stuffing with fiberfill before closing.

Buttons

With yarn needle and length of black yarn, sew 3 French knots down upper front of body.

Sew head to center top of body.

Collar

Row 1 (RS): With light periwinkle yarn, ch 12, sc, hdc, dc and hdc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc and sc in next ch, [sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch] 3 times, sc in next ch, sc and hdc in next ch, hdc, dc, hdc, sc and sl st in last ch, fasten off.

Row 2 (WS): Attach skipper blue yarn in opposite side of foundation ch, sl st in each st around entire outer edge of collar, fasten off.

Sew collar around neckline with ends joined at center front.

Arms

Make 2

Rnd 1 (RS): With off-white yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (6 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, fasten off.

Rnd 3: Attach light periwinkle yarn, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 5 sc, join in beg sc. (6 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, working in back lps for this rnd only, sc in each st around, join in beg sc.

Rnds 5–9: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc.

At the end of Rnd 9, fasten off.

Rnd 10: Attach skipper blue yarn in

rem free lp of Rnd 3, sl st in each st around, fasten off.

Stuff Rnds 1–5 only with fiberfill.

Flatten Rnd 10 straight across; sew to shoulder area of body.

Legs

Make 2

Rnd 1 (RS): With light periwinkle yarn, ch 4, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook (heel), sc in next ch, 5 sc in last ch, working on opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next ch, join in beg sc. (10 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, join in beg sc.

(13 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same st as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 4 sc, [dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] 3 times, sc in each of next 2 sc, join in beg sc. (10 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 3 sc, [dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] 3 times, join in beg sc. (7 sc)

Rnds 5–10: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc. (7 sc)

At the end of Rnd 10, fasten off. Stuff legs with fiberfill. With toes facing forward, flatten Rnd 10 straight across; sew legs side by side at bottom of body.



Tender

Size

6 1/2" long

Pattern Notes

Cut additional plastic canvas pieces not graphed as listed below:

Inner Sides: Cut 2 (32 x 16 holes).

Inner Ends: Cut 2 (14 x 16 holes).

Inner Bottom: Cut 32 x 14 holes.

Outer Ends: Cut 2 (22 x 20 holes).

Outer Sides: Cut 2 (40 x 20 holes).

Outer Bottom: Cut 40 x 22 holes.

Basic Wheels (optional): Cut outer 4 rounds from 4 (3") radial circles. Use center circles.

With yarn needle and tangerine yarn, Whipstitch plastic canvas inner sides to inner ends and top section to inner sides and inner ends.

Top

Row 1 (RS): With tangerine yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

First edge

Row 3 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 4–19: Ch 1, sc in 2 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 19, ch 7, fasten off.

Second edge

Row 3 (RS): Sk next 7 sc of Row 2, attach tangerine yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 4–19: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, working across ch-7 of Row 19 of first edge, sc in each of next 7 chs, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (11 sc)

Row 21: Ch 1, sc in each of next 11 sc, fasten off.

Inner Sides

Rnd 1: Working around inner edge of top, attach tangerine yarn in first skipped sc of Row 2, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 6 sc, work 1 sc in side edge of each of Rows 3–19 (17 sc), working across opposite side of ch, work 7 sc across, work 1 sc in side edge of each Rows 19–3 (17 sc), join in beg sc. (48 sc)

Rnds 2–8: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc.

At the end of Rnd 8, fasten off.

Sew outer edge of crocheted top to outer edge of plastic canvas top. Sew Rnd 8 of inner sides to bottom edge of plastic canvas inner sides.

Inner Bottom

Row 1: With tangerine yarn, ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (6 sc)

Rows 2–16: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 16, fasten off.

Sew to plastic canvas inner bottom and then sew to bottom of inner sides and ends.

Outer Ends

Make 2

Note: Crocheted outer ends are sewn to plastic canvas vertically.

Row 1: With tangerine yarn, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (9 sc)

Rows 2–12: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 12, fasten off.

Sew crocheted outer ends to plastic canvas outer ends.

Outer Sides

Make 2

Note: Crocheted outer sides are sewn to plastic canvas vertically.

Row 1: With tangerine yarn, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (9 sc)

Rows 2–22: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 22, fasten off.

Sew crocheted outer sides to plastic canvas outer sides.

Sew outer ends and outer sides tog at side seams. Sew top to outer ends and outer sides.

Bottom

Row 1: With tangerine yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–22: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 22, fasten off. Sew crocheted bottom to plastic canvas bottom. Set aside.

Basic Wheels

Make 4

Note: Make 8 sections for 4 wheels; 2 are joined for each wheel.

First half

Rnd 1 (RS): With black yarn, ch 2, 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc, drop black yarn to back of work, do not fasten off. (10 sc)

Rnd 2 (RS): With nickel yarn, ch 1, work 2 sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, draw up a lp of black yarn, fasten off nickel yarn. (20 sc)

Rnd 3 (RS): Ch 1, [fpdc around sc of Rnd 1, sk sc directly behind fpdc, sc in next sc] 10 times, join in beg fpdc, fasten off.

Second half

Rnds 1–3: Rep Rnds 1–3 of first half, do not fasten off.

Rnd 4: Holding 2 wheel sections tog with plastic canvas sandwiched between, working through both thicknesses, sl st around, fasten off.

Sew 2 wheels to each side of tender so that top half of wheel is attached to tender.

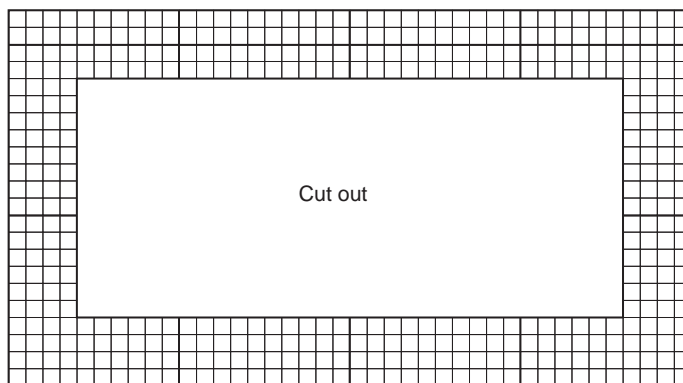

This knuckle will be sewn to center front bottom with snap facing upward. Sew half of a snap fastener to 2nd knuckle. This knuckle will be sewn to center back bottom with snap fastener facing downward. Fill tender with lollipops to represent coal.

Roof Ridge: Cut 60 x 3 holes.

Door Rails: Cut 2 (38 x 2 holes).

Basic Wheels (optional): Cut outer 4 rounds from 4 (3") radial circles. Use center circles.

Bottom

Row 1: With emerald green yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–32: Ch 1, sc in each of next 11 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 32, fasten off. Sew crocheted bottom to plastic canvas bottom.

Ends

Make 2

Row 1: With emerald green yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc

in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 11 sc, turn.

Row 19: Ch 1, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, turn. (9 sc)

Row 20: Ch 1, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, fasten off. (7 sc)

Sew crocheted ends to plastic canvas ends.

Brake Wheel

Rnd 1: With crochet hook size D and black yarn, ch 6, [dc, ch 3] 5 times in first ch of beg ch-6, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-6.

Rnd 2: Working in back lps only, sl st in each ch and each dc

around, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

With yarn needle and rem length of yarn, sew wheel to upper left corner of back end section, 1 st in from edge.

From center bottom of wheel, with black yarn, backstitch 2 cable lines to bottom edge of end.

Boxcar Head

Face

Rnd 1: With white yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (5 sc)

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 3: Work 2 sc in each sc around. (10 sc)

Rnd 4: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] rep around. (15 sc)

Rnd 5: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice, 5 sc in next sc (cheek), [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times, sc in next sc, 5 sc in next sc (cheek), sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc. (29 sc)

Rnd 6: [Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] twice, *draw up a lp in each of next 5 sc, yo, draw through all 6 lps on hook (cheek) *, [sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times, sc in next sc, rep from * to * once, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc. (27 sc)

Rnd 7: Sc in each sc around, sl st in next st, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Right Ear

Row 1: Working in front lps only of last rnd of head in 2 sts adjacent to cheek, attach white yarn in upper st at right edge, ch 2, 3 dc and 1 hdc in same st, 3 sc and sl st in next st, fasten off.

Left Ear

Row 1: Working in front lps only of last rnd of head in 2 sts adjacent to cheek, attach white yarn with sl st in lower st at left edge, 3 sc in same st as sl st, 1 hdc, 3 dc in next st, ch 2, sl st in same st, fasten off.

Mouth

With yarn needle and length of jockey red yarn, sew 4 backstitches centered under nose between Rnds 5 and 6.

Hair

Working on center top 5 sts of Rnd 7 of head, attach jockey red yarn in front lp, ch 6, sl st in same st, ch 6, [sl st in next st, ch 6, sl st in same st, ch 6] rep across the 5 sts in front lps only, turn and rep in same manner on rem back lps of same 5 sts at top of head, ending with sl st in same st as beg ch-6, fasten off.

Eyes

Sew 15mm eyes centered above nose and cheeks.

Apply a small amount of blusher to highlight nose, ears and cheeks.

With yarn needle and rem length of white yarn, sew head to rem end of boxcar centered 2 rows down from top, stuffing with fiberfill as work progresses.

Bow Tie

Row 1: With paddy green yarn, leaving a 4" tail at beg, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook (center), turn. (1 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, 3 sc in the 1 sc, turn. (3 sc)

Rows 3–7: Ch 1, sc in each 3 sc, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, draw up a lp in each of next 3 sc, yo, draw through all 4 lps on hook, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in the 1 sc (center), turn.

Rows 10–17: Rep Rows 2–9.

At the end of Row 17, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Knot beg and ending lengths tog.

Wrap ending length around center of bow tie several times (center is Rows 1, 9 and 17; knot to secure. Sew bow tie centered at bottom of head.

Sides

Make 2

Row 1: With emerald green yarn, ch 31, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (30 sc)

Rows 2–18: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

Sew center supports as indicated on graph to each side.

Side Doors

Make 2

Note: Side doors are worked vertically.

Row 1 (WS): With emerald green yarn, ch 16, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (15 sc)

Rows 2–13: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each st across, turn.

At the end of Row 13, fasten off.

For side door handle, with yarn needle and length of paddy green yarn, sew a 1/2" straight st, centered, over Row 1 or 2.

Sew crocheted doors to plastic canvas doors. Sew a door, centered, on each side section with bottom of each door at bottom edge of each side.

Sew each end section to each end of sides.

Roof

First half

Row 1 (RS): Starting at center top of roof with emerald green yarn, ch 31, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (30 sc)

Rows 2–8: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in each st across, turn.

At end of Row 8, fasten off.

Second half

Row 1 (RS): Attach emerald green yarn in opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (30 sc)

Rows 2–8: Rep Rows 2–8 of first half.

Sew crocheted roof to plastic canvas roof.

Roof ridge

With yarn needle and paddy green yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast plastic canvas roof ridge.

Sew roof ridge over center top of roof.

Door Rails

Make 2

With yarn needle and paddy green yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast each plastic canvas door rail.

Sew a door rail across top of each door, extending across side at end of car.

Ladders

Make 2

With yarn needle and black yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast each plastic canvas ladder.

Sew a ladder to each side of boxcar at opposite end of door rail, 2 sts in from end.

Basic Wheels

Make 4

Rep basic wheels of tender.

Sew 2 wheels to each side of boxcar so that top half of wheel is attached to boxcar.

Finishing

Sew roof onto boxcar. With fiberfill,

firmly stuff each of the 3 chambers between supports.

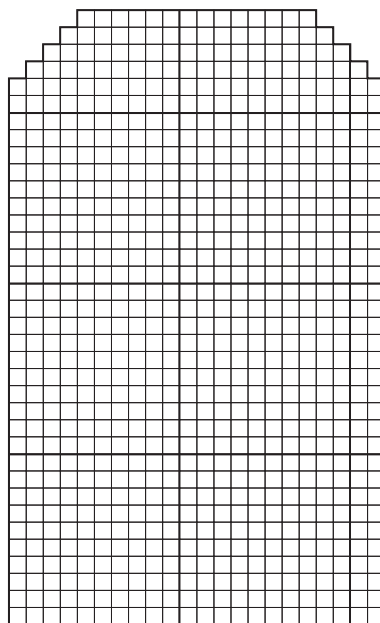

Side Top Braces: Cut 2 (60 x 5 holes).

End Top Braces: Cut 2 (22 x 5 holes).

Basic Wheels (optional): Cut outer 4 rounds from 4 (3") radial circles. Use center circles.

Save the cut-out shaded pieces of the sides of livestock car to form slats. To make sides more sturdy, tack cut-out pieces to the vertical slats, with yarn needle and yellow yarn. Since you will need 16 slats, cut 2 more vertical slats from scrap plastic canvas.

Bottom

Make 2

Note: The 2 bottom pieces form the base of the car when sewn to sides and ends, which allows a 5-hole-deep area to be stuffed with fiberfill to make car sturdier.

Row 1: With yellow yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–32: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 32, fasten off.

Sew 1 crocheted piece to each plastic canvas bottom.

Ends

Make 2

Row 1: With yellow yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–15: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 15, fasten off.

Row 16: Attach yellow yarn in opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 17–30: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 30, fasten off.

End Top Braces

Make 2

Row 1: With yellow yarn, ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 2 chs, turn. (3 sc)

Rows 2–12: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 12, fasten off.

Side Top Braces

Make 2

Row 1: Rep Row 1 of end top braces.

Rows 2–32: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (3 sc)

At the end of Row 32, fasten off.

Sew end and side top braces to corresponding plastic canvas pieces.

Sides

Make 2

First half

Row 1 (RS): With yellow yarn, ch 31, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (30 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

First vertical slat

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 4–12: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 12, fasten off.

Second vertical slat

Row 3: With finished vertical slat to the right, sk next 2 sc, attach yellow yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, turn.

Rows 4–12: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 12, fasten off.

For 3rd–8th vertical slats, rep 2nd vertical slat.

Row 13 (RS): Attach yellow yarn in

first sc at edge of Row 12 of first vertical slat, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, [ch 2, sc in each of next 2 sc of next vertical slat] 7 times, turn.

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, [sc in each of next 2 chs, sc in each of next 2 sc] 7 times, turn. (30 sc)

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each of next 30 sc, fasten off.

Second half

Row 1 (RS): With opposite side of foundation ch facing, attach yellow yarn in first ch, ch 1, sc in same ch as beg ch-1, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (30 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

First vertical slat

Rows 3–12: Rep Rows 3–12 of first vertical slat for first half.

Second vertical slat

Rows 3–12: Rep Rows 3–12 of 2nd vertical slat for first half.

For 3rd–8th vertical slats, rep 2nd vertical slat.

Rows 13–15: Rep Rows 13–15 of first side.

Sandwich plastic canvas side piece between first and 2nd halves, with RS out and foundation ch at bottom.

With yarn needle and length of yellow yarn, working through both thicknesses throughout, sew both halves tog across Row 15 at top edge. Continue to sew around entire outer edge and around all edges of slats.

Sew ends to sides; sew end top braces and side top braces to top edges.

Sew 1 bottom piece face up around entire inner edge at base of the vertical portion of slats (up 5 holes from the bottom on plastic canvas sides and ends).

Basic Wheels

Make 4

Rep basic wheels of tender.

Sew 2 wheels to each side of livestock car so that top half of wheel is attached to livestock car.

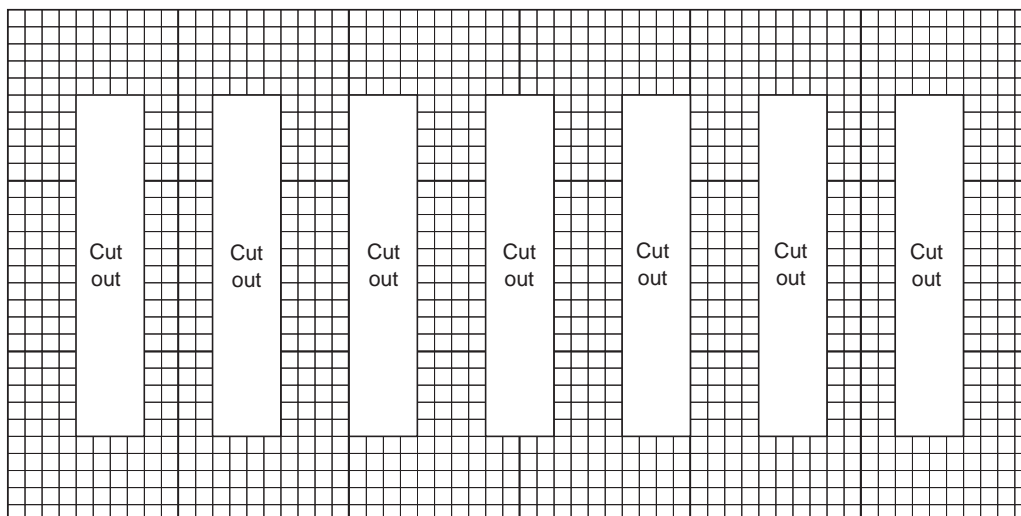

Knuckles

With yellow yarn, rep Rows 1–18 of engine knuckle.
Sew crocheted piece over plastic canvas. Sew rem half of snap fastener left from boxcar to rounded end centered over Row 2. Sew

knuckle to bottom center front with snap facing upward. Sew half of a snap fastener to 2nd knuckle. Sew centered to center back bottom with snap fastener facing down.

Crochet passenger of caboose first

as he is secured in the car as work progresses.

Do not join any sections of caboose until indicated. Detailed section would be difficult to attach if joined prior to indication.

Passenger

Nose

Rnd 1: With off-white yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Head

Rnds 1–5: Rep Rnds 1–5 of engineer.

With yarn needle, thread rem length of yarn from nose; weave through sts of Rnd 1; pull to close; secure. Sew nose centered over Rnd 1 of head. Secure at back; fasten off.

Eyes

Secure 12mm eyes to head.

Mouth

Rep mouth of engineer.

Mustache

Rep mustache of engineer.

Rnds 6–10: Rep Rnds 6–10. At the end of Rnd 10, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Hair

Rep hair of engineer.

Cap

Rnd 1 (RS): With tangerine yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (5 sc)

Rnds 2 & 3: Ch 1, work 2 sc in each sc around, join in beg sc. (20 sc)

Rnds 4 & 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc.

Row 6: Sl st in next sc, sc in next sc, hdc and dc in next sc, 2 dc in each of next 2 sc, dc and hdc in next sc, sc in next sc, sl st in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

With yarn needle and rem length of tangerine yarn, sew cap to head.

Body

Make 2

Rnds 1–5: With tangerine yarn, rep Rnds 1–5 of engineer body.

At the end of Rnd 5 of first section, fasten off. Do not fasten off 2nd section.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 7 of engineer body.

Sew head to center top of body.

Collar

Row 1 (RS): With tangerine yarn, rep Row 1 of engineer collar.

Sew collar around neckline with ends joined at center front.

Arms

Make 2

Rnds 1–6: With off-white and tangerine yarn, rep Rnds 1–6 of engineer arms.

At the end of Rnd 6, fasten off.

Stuff Rnds 1–3 only with fiberfill.

Flatten Rnd 6 straight across; sew to shoulder area of body. Tack hands tog at center front of body.

Legs

Make 2

Rnds 1–7: With tangerine yarn, rep Rnds 1–7 of engineer legs.

Stuff legs with fiberfill. With toes facing forward, flatten Rnd 7 straight across, sew legs side by side at bottom of body.

Caboose

Sides

Make 2

Note: Foundation ch is bottom of side sections.

First half

Row 1: With jockey red yarn, ch 32, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (31 sc)

Rows 2–9: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

First end

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

Rows 11–14: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 14, fasten off.

First center piece

Row 10: With first end to the right, sk next 5 sc sts of Row 9, attach jockey red yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 4 sc, turn. (5 sc)

Rows 11–14: Ch 1, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 14, fasten off.

Second center piece

Row 10: With first center piece to the right, sk next 5 sc sts of Row 9, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 4 sc, turn. (5 sc)

Rows 11–14: Ch 1, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn.

At the end of Row 14, fasten off.

Second end

Row 10: With 2nd center piece to the right, sk next 5 sc sts of Row 9, attach jockey red yarn in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (3 sc)

Rows 11–14: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

Row 15: Working across sts of each section in sts of Row 14, ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 5, [sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 5] twice, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

Row 16: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 5 chs, [sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in each of next 5 chs] twice, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn. (31 sc)

Row 17: Ch 1, sc in each of next 31 sc, fasten off.

Second half

Row 1: Attach jockey red yarn in opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (31 sc)

Rows 2–17: Rep all portions of first half.

With jockey red yarn, sew crocheted side to plastic canvas side as for livestock car.

Window Frames

Make 6

With yarn needle and length of cherry red yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast each plastic canvas window frame.

Sew a window frame over each opening on sides.

Ends

Make 2

Row 1: With jockey red yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–9: Ch 1, sc in each sc

across, turn.

Rows 10–14: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn. (3 sc)

At the end of Row 14, fasten off.

Sk next 5 sts of Row 9, attach jockey red yarn in next sc, rep Rows 10–14, do not fasten off at the end of Row 14, turn. (3 sc)

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 5, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

Row 16: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 5 chs, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 17 & 18: Ch 1, sc in each of next 11 sc, turn.

Row 19: Ch 1, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, turn. (9 sc)

Row 20: Rep Row 19, fasten off. (7 sc)

Attach jockey red in opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rep Rows 2–20 to complete opposite side of end section.

With foundation ch centered on bottom edge of plastic canvas end and RS out, sew crocheted piece around entire outer edge and around window opening.

Door Frames

Make 2

With yarn needle and length of cherry red yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast each plastic canvas door frame.

Sew a door frame over each door opening on ends.

With yarn needle and black yarn, embroider a French knot for a doorknob on right edge to the left of door frame on each end.

Inner Supports

Make 2

Row 1: With jockey red yarn, ch 11, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (10 sc)

Rows 2–17: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rows 18 & 19: Ch 1, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, turn. (6 sc)

Rows 20 & 21: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (10 sc)

Rows 22–38: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 38, fasten off.

With Row 1 and Row 38 at bottom edge of plastic canvas inner support, sew around entire outer edge.

Base

Make 2

Row 1: With jockey red yarn, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 2–40: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 40, fasten off.

Hold 2 plastic canvas base sections tog; sew only 1 crocheted piece to canvas pieces. The crocheted section that is attached is the inside edge of base. Rem crocheted base will be sewn to bottom later.

Basic Wheels

Make 4

Rep basic wheels for tender.

Sew 2 wheels to each side of caboose so that top half of wheel is attached to caboose.

Center and sew 1 side edge of 1 assembled inner support between first and 2nd windows of 1 assembled side. Sew rem side edge to corresponding position on 2nd assembled side. Rep between 2nd and 3rd windows of sides with rem inner support.

Sew the base to sides, centering the 40 sc rows of base on the 31 sts of sides. Sew inner supports to base also.

Place passenger in sitting position inside 1 end of the caboose facing outward. This will be the front of the caboose. Secure the passenger by tacking back of body to inner support.

With door frame facing outward, sew each end to sides and bottom.

Sew rem crocheted base to bottom of caboose.

End Rails

Make 2

With yarn needle and black yarn, Continental Stitch each plastic canvas end rail.

With WS of 2 end rails facing, Whipstitch entire outer edge of 2 sections tog, including the inner edges between rails.

Sew 1 end rail to each end of base.

Knuckle

Make 1

Rows 1–18: With jockey red yarn, rep Rows 1–18 of engine knuckle.

Sew crocheted piece over plastic canvas. Sew rem half of snap fastener left from livestock car to the rounded end centered over Row 2. Sew knuckle to center front bottom of caboose with snap fastener facing upward.

Roof

Make 2

First half

Row 1 (RS): Starting at center, with jockey red yarn, ch 41, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (40 sc)

Rows 2–8: Working in back lps only, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

At the end of Row 8, fasten off.

Second half

Row 1 (RS): With opposite side of foundation ch facing, attach jockey red, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (40 sc)

Rows 2–8: Rep Rows 2–8 of first half.

Sew 1 crocheted section to top of roof. Second (underside) section of roof will be sewn on later.

Roof Ridge

With yarn needle and cherry red yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast roof ridge.

Sew roof ridge to center top of roof.

Cupola Ends

Make 2

First half

Row 1 (RS): Starting at top edge, with jockey red yarn, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (9 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, ch 1, sl st in same sc as last sc, sl st in each of next 3 sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc as ch-1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 3, sk 3 unworked sts, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in each of next 3 chs, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn. (13 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, fasten off. (1 sc)

Sk next 9 sts of Row 4, attach jockey red yarn in next sc, rep Rows 5 and 6.

Second half

Row 1: Attach yarn in opposite side of foundation ch of first half, ch 1, sc in each of next 9 chs, turn. (9 sc)

Rep complete section of first half. With foundation ch over top edge of plastic canvas cupola end and RS out, sew around entire outer edge; sew around window opening.

Cupola Sides

Make 2

First half

Row 1: With victory red yarn, ch 11, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (10 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in next sc, [ch 1, sl st in same sc, sl st in each of next 2 sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, sc in same sc] 3 times, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in sc, [ch 2, sc in next sc] 3 times, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in sc, [sc in each of next 2 chs, sc in next sc] 3 times, turn. (10 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, fasten off.

Second half

Row 1: Working in opposite side of foundation ch, attach jockey red yarn, ch 1, sc in each of next 10 chs, turn.

Rows 2–5: Rep Rows 2–5 of first half.

Sew crocheted piece over plastic canvas cupola side around entire outer edge and around each window.

Sew cupola sides and ends tog. Position assembled unit 2" from end of caboose roof; sew in place.

Row 1 (RS): Starting at center with jockey red yarn, ch 11, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (10 sc)

Rows 2–6: Working in back lps only, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

At the end of Row 6, fasten off.

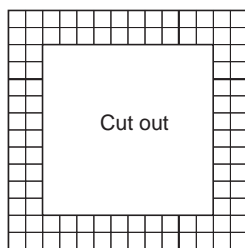

Rows 2–6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 6, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Bottom

Row 1: With black yarn, ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (8 sc)

Sew open end of vertical post to center of base bottom of plastic canvas.

Sew crocheted bottom to plastic canvas base bottom.

Note: Sew plastic canvas base sides to plastic canvas base top.

Rows 1–4: Rep Rows 1–4 of bottom. (8 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 2, sk 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sc, turn.

With yarn needle and off-white yarn, Continental Stitch plastic canvas sign with the exception of the outer edge; Overcast outer edge with black yarn.

With yarn needle and black yarn, Backstitch “STOP ON SIGNAL” on front, as indicated on graph.

Back

Row 1: With black yarn, ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (8 sc)

Rows 2–6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

At the end of Row 6, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off. Sew crocheted back to back of sign. Sew sign centered on vertical post 1" from base.

Railroad Crossing Light Light bar (make 2)

With yarn needle and black yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast each plastic canvas light bar.

Light cover (make 2)

With yarn needle and black yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast each plastic canvas light cover.

Lights (make 2)

Rnd 1: With jockey red yarn, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join. (5 sc)

Rnd 2: Sl st in each sc around, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Sew 1 light to each side of light bar centered on each rounded end. Sew a light cover over each light. Holding front and back of light bar tog, sew around each outer rounded edge; do not sew over the 12-hole area at center (the center horizontal portion of light bar).

Open center portion (12-hole area of front and back) and slide over vertical post about 3/4" above "Stop on Signal" sign. With yarn

needle and black yarn, tack through center of light bar and vertical post to secure.

"Railroad Crossing" Sign

Make 2

With yarn needle and off-white yarn, Continental Stitch and Overcast plastic canvas "Crossing" sign and "Railroad" sign.

With yarn needle and black yarn, Backstitch "CROSSING" and "RAILROAD" on signs following graphs.

X-Shape Back

Row 1: With off-white yarn, ch 15, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (14 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of next 14 sc, fasten off.

Row 3: Attach off-white yarn in 7th sc of Row 2, ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, sc in next sc, turn. (2 sc)

Rows 4-8: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn.

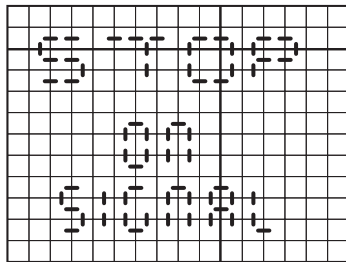

Gauge

4 sc and 4 sc rows = 1" with size G hook

Pattern Notes

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Use crochet hook size G throughout unless otherwise indicated. Join rnds with a sl st unless otherwise stated; when rnds are not joined, mark last st of each rnd with CC or other marker.

For the safety of little ones, do not use eyeglasses, sew-on eyes, liberty bell and mushroom birds for children under 3. Instead, crochet small (5-sc) circles with size C hook for eyes.

When working with alternating colors, carry unused color on back of work; do not fasten off unless otherwise stated.

Measurements of each plastic canvas section are calculated

by a specific number of holes, not inches, unless otherwise indicated.

Cut plastic canvas pieces for each section of train before beg. Patterns are given for cutting wheels and boiler front and back from 7-count plastic canvas or radial circles (see circle templates on page 2). You will need only 13 sheets of canvas if using optional radial circles for these patterns.

Always sew sections of plastic canvas and unit sections with same color yarn with which they were crocheted.

When each piece of this project is completed, no plastic canvas will show.

Pattern Stitches

Bpsc: With RS facing, insert hook from back to front to back around the vertical portion of indicated st, yo, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook.

Fphdc: Yo hook, insert hook from front to back to front again around the vertical post (upright part) of indicated st, complete hdc as usual.

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
