Flower Bookmarks

Skill Level

Beginner

Size

Pansy Bookmark: 7 1/2 inches
Daisy Bookmark: 8 1/2 inches

Materials

- Crochet cotton size 10: 20 yds white, 14 yds green, 6 yds shaded yellows, 3 yds each yellow and black
- Size 7 steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

Pansy Bookmark: 4 dc fan rows = 1 inch; Daisy Bookmark: 3 shell rows = 1 inch

Check gauge to save time.

Pattern Notes

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join rnds with a sl st unless otherwise stated.

Pattern Stitches

Fan st: 5 dc in indicated st.

Rice st: Sc in indicated st, ch 3, dc in sc just made.

Shell: [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in indicated st.

P: Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook.

3-dc cl: [Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times in same sp, yo, draw through all 4 lps on hook.

PANSY BOOKMARK

Pansy

Rnd 1 (RS): With yellow, ch 6, join

to form a ring, ch 1, [sc in ring, ch 3] 3 times, sc in ring, ch 4, 5 dc in ring, remove hook, insert hook in first dc of 5-dc group, pick up dropped lp and draw through st on hook, ch 4, join in beg sc, fasten off.

Rnd 2: Attach black in first sc of Rnd 1, ch 1, [{sc, 5 dc, sc} in ch-3 sp] 3 times, [{sc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, sc} in next ch-4 sp] twice, join in beg sc, fasten off.

Rnd 3: Attach shaded yellows in first sc of Rnd 2, ch 3, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc, 2 sc in next dc, sc in next sc (first petal), sl st in next sc, ch 3, 2 dc in each of next 5 dc, ch 3, sl st in next sc (2nd petal), sc in next sc, 2 sc in next dc, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc, ch 3, sl st in next sc (3rd petal), [sc in next sc, 2 dc in next dc, 3 tr in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next dc, sc in next sc] twice (2 large petals), join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3, fasten off.

Leaves

Make 2

Rnd 1: With green, ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 3 chs, hdc in next ch, [sc, ch 2, sc] in last ch, working in rem lps on opposite side of foundation ch, hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 3 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in each of next 2 chs, join in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining, sc in each st across to ch-2 sp, [sc, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc] in ch-2 sp, sc in each rem st across, join in beg sc, leaving a length for sewing, fasten off.

Bookmark

Row 1: Beg at bottom of bookmark, with white, ch 22, dc in 6th ch from hook, [sk 2 chs, fan st in next ch, sk 2 chs, dc in next ch, ch 1, sk 1 ch, dc in next ch] twice, turn.

Rows 2–25: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch-1), dc in next dc, [sk next 2 dc, fan st in next dc, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc] twice, turn, at the end of Row 25, do not turn.



Edging

Row 1: Ch 1, working across ends of rows, rice st in each row across side, in every 3rd rem lp on opposite side of foundation ch and in each row across opposite side, fasten off. With tapestry needle and rem length for sewing, sew leaves to pansy; sew pansy to top of bookmark.

DAISY BOOKMARK

Daisy

Rnd 1: With yellow, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in beg sc. (6 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, join in beg sc, fasten off. (12 sc)

Rnd 3: Working in front lps this rnd only, attach white in any st of Rnd 2,

[ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in each of next 2 chs, sc in each of next 2 chs, sl st in next st of Rnd 2] rep around, ending with sl st in back lp of next st of Rnd 2.

Rnd 4: Working in rem back lps of Rnd 2, [ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in each of next 2 chs, sc in each of next 2 chs, sl st in next st of Rnd 2] rep around, join at base of beg ch-7, leaving a length for sewing, fasten off.

Bookmark

Row 1: Beg at bottom of bookmark with green, ch 1 (for center ch), ch 3 more (for first dc), [2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in center ch, turn.

Rows 2–21: Ch 5, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn, at the end of Row 21, do not turn.

Edging

Rnd 1: Ch 5, working across side of bookmark, *[3-dc cl, p, ch 3] 3 times in next ch-5 sp, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, rep from * 4 times, ch 2, [4 dc, p, 3 dc] in bottom of first shell (center ch), ch 5, rep from * across opposite side of bookmark, ending with [4 dc, p, 3 dc] in ch-2 sp of shell of Row 21, join in top of last dc of Row 21 shell, fasten off.

With tapestry needle and rem length for sewing, sew daisy to top of bookmark.

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
