FINISHED SIZES:

12 mos.: 11 1/2 oz. (326 g) fuchsia and 3 1/2 oz. (99.2 g) white, D (3.25 mm) hook.

18 mos.: 13 1/2 oz. (383 g) fuchsia and 3 1/2 oz. (106.3 g) white, E (3.5 mm) hook.

24 mos.: 15 oz. (425.3 g) fuchsia and 4 oz. (113.4 g) white, F (3.75 mm) hook.

MATERIALS:

Sport yarn: fuchsia and white in amounts needed for size; 24" (61 cm) white 5/8" (16 mm) grosgrain ribbon; 3 white 5/8" (16 mm) shank buttons; 3 white 3/4" (19 mm) shank buttons; white sewing thread; sewing needle; crochet hook needed to obtain gauge for size.

GAUGE:

12 mos.: 9 sc = 2" (5.1 cm); Rows 1-16 of Bodice = 4 1/2" (11.4 cm).

18 mos.: 17 sc = 4" (10.2 cm); Rows 1-16 of Bodice = 5" (12.7 cm).

24 mos.: 4 sc = 1" (2.5 cm); Rows 1-16 of Bodice = 5 1/2" (14 cm).

BODICE

Row 1: With fuchsia, ch 53, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 5 chs, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch, *sc in next 12 chs, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch; repeat from * 2 more times, sc in last 6 chs, turn (56 sc, 4 ch-2 sps).

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in each st across with (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp, turn (64 dc, 4 ch-2 sps).

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across with (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch sp, turn, fasten off (72 sc, 4 ch-2 sps).

NOTE: For small cross stitch (sm cr st), skip next st, dc in next st; working over dc just made, dc in skipped st.

Row 4: Join white with sl st in first st, ch 3, *sm cr st across to next ch sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch sp; repeat from * 3 more times, sm cr st across to last st, dc in last st (35 sm cr sts, 10 dc, 4 ch-2 sps).

Row 5: Repeat row 3 (88 sc, 4 ch-2 sps).

Row 6: Join fuchsia with A st in first st, ch 3, dc in each st across with (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp, turn (96 dc, 4 ch-2 sps).

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each st across with (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch sp, turn (104 sc, 4 ch-2 sps).

Rows 8-12: Repeat rows 2-6, ending with 144 dc, 4 ch-2 sps.

Row 13: Ch 1, for right back, sc in first 18 sts, sc in next ch sp; for first armhole, ch 9, skip next 36 sts; for front, sc in next ch sp, sc in next 36 sts, sc in next ch sp; for second armhole, ch 9, skip next 36 sts; for left back, sc in next ch sp, sc in last 18 sts, turn (76 sc, 2 ch-9 sps).

Row 14: Ch 3, dc in each st and in each ch across, turn (94 dc).

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each st across, do not turn or fasten off.

BUTTONHOLE PLACKET

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, ch 1, evenly space 23 sc across, turn (23 sc).

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts; for buttonhole, ch 1, skip next 2 sts; (sc in next 5 sts, ch 1, skip next 2 sts) 2 times, sc in each of last 3 sts, turn (17 sc, 3 buttonholes).

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each st and 2 sc in each ch-1 sp across, turn.

Row 5: Repeat row 2, fasten off.

BUTTON PLACKET

Row 1: Working in ends of rows across right back, join fuchsia with sc in first row, evenly space 22 more sc across, turn (23 sc).

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

NECK TRIM

Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Bodice and in ends of rows on Plackets, join fuchsia with sc in first row on Button Placket, reverse sc in each row and in each ch across, fasten off.

SLEEVES

Rnd 1: Working around one armhole, join fuchsia with sc in center ch at underarm, sc in same ch, sc in each of next 4 chs, sc in next ch sp, sc in



next 36 sts, sc in next ch sp, sc in each of last 4 chs, join with sl st in first sc (48 sc).

NOTES: For medium cross stitch (med cr st), skip next st, dc in next st, ch 1; working over dc just made, dc in skipped st.

For single crochet post stitch (sc fp), insert hook from front to back around post of next st, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through all 3 lps on hook.

For double crochet front post stitch (dc fp), yo, insert hook from front to back around post of next st, yo, draw lp through, (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) 2 times.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 4, med cr st, ch 1, (dc in next st, ch 1, med cr st, ch 1) around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of ch-4 (16 dc, 16 med cr sts).

Rnds 3-7: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 4, skip next ch sp, med cr st, ch 1, skip next ch sp, (dc fp, ch 1, skip next ch sp, med cr st, ch 1, skip next ch sp) around, join.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, skip next ch sp, sc in next ch sp, skip next ch sp, (sc fp around next st, skip next ch sp, sc in next ch sp, skip next ch sp) around, join with sl st in first sc fp (32 sts).

Rnds 9-12: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 13: Sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first sl st, fasten off. Repeat in other armhole.

SKIRT

Rnd 1: Working in sts on last row of Bodice and in ends of rows on Plackets, place Buttonhole Placket over Button Placket; matching rows and working through both thicknesses, join white with sl st in 3rd row, ch 3, sm cr st over next 2 rows, sm cr st around Bodice, sm cr st over last 2 rows on Plackets, join with sl st in top of ch-3 (49 sm cr sts, 1 dc).

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc, fasten off (99 sc).

Rnd 3: Join fuchsia with sl st in first st, ch 3, sm cr st, (ch 1, sm cr st) around, join with sl st in top of ch-3 (49 sm cr sts, 48 ch-1 sps, 1 dc).

Rnd 4: Ch 3, sm cr st, (dc in next ch sp, sm cr st) around, join (49 sm cr sts, 49 dc).

Rnds 5-7: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 3, med cr st, (dc fp, med cr st) around, join.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 4, med cr st, ch 1, (dc fp, ch 1, med cr st, ch 1) around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rnds 9-12: Repeat md 3 of Sleeve.

NOTES: For large cross stitch (lg cr st), skip next st, dc in next st, ch 2; working over dc just made, dc in skipped st.

For treble crochet front post stitch (tr fp), yo 2 times, insert hook from front to back around post of next st, yo, draw lp through, (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) 3 times.

Rnds 13-20: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 5, skip next ch sp, lg cr st, ch 2, skip next ch sp, (dc fp, ch 2, skip next ch sp, med cr st, ch 2, skip next ch sp) around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5.

Rnd 21: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 4, skip next ch sp, 9 tr in next ch sp, skip next ch sp, (tr fp, skip next ch

sp, 9 tr in next ch sp, skip next ch sp) around, join with sl st in top of ch-4.

Rnd 22: Ch 1, sc fp around first st, ch 3, dc in back lp of next 9 sts, (dc fp, dc in back lp of next 9 sts) around, join with sl st in top of ch-3, fasten off.

Rnd 23: Join white with sl st in first st, ch 1, sc fp around same st, sc in back lp of next 9 sts, (sc fp around next st, sc in back lp of next 9 sts) around, join with sl st in first sc, fasten off.

Sew smaller buttons on Button Placket opposite buttonholes.


Sew one large button to center front of each fuchsia stripe on Bodice as shown in photo.

Cut ribbon in half, tie each piece into a bow. Tack one bow to each Sleeve as shown.

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
