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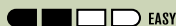

## SKILL LEVEL



## FINISHED SIZE

9½ x 12½ inches

## MATERIALS

- DMC Pearl Cotton size 5 (27 yds per skein):
  - 3 skeins #988 medium forest green
  - 2 skeins each #309 dark rose and #796 dark royal blue
  - 1 skein each #977 light golden brown and #823 dark navy blue
- DMC Cebelia size 30 crochet cotton:
  - 2 yds #B5200 white
- Sizes 10/1.15mm and 6/1.80mm steel crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Embroidery needle
- Sewing needle and thread
- 3mm blue beads: 5
- 3mm black bead
- ¼-inch long black tubular beads: 2

## GAUGE

**Size 6 hook:** 5 dc = ½ inch;  
5 dc rows = ½ inch; 7 pineapple rows = 1¾ inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Chain-6 at beginning of row counts as first treble crochet, chain 2 unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

### 3-double crochet cluster

**(3-dc cl):** [Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo, draw up a lp, yo,

draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times, yo, draw through all 4 lps on hook.

**Scallop:** (Sc, dc, ch 2, dc, sc) in same st.

**Shell:** (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st or sp.

**Beginning shell (beg shell):** (Ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st or sp.

## TAIL

**Row 1 (RS):** With size 6 hook and light golden brown, ch 8, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first ch to form a ring, **ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), 11 dc in ring, turn. (12 dc)

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in same dc as beg ch-3, 2 dc in each rem dc across, turn. (24 dc)

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in same dc as beg ch-3, dc in each of next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, turn. (32 dc)

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of next 15 dc, 2 sc in next dc, sc in each of next 16 dc, turn. (33 sc)

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, [sk next sc, 5 dc in next sc, sk next sc, sc in next sc] across, turn. (8 5-dc groups)

**Row 6:** Ch 3, 3 dc in first sc, sc in 3rd dc of next 5-dc group, [7 dc in next sc, sc in 3rd dc of next 5-dc group] across, ending with 4 dc in last sc, turn. (7 7-dc groups, 2 4-dc groups)

**Row 7 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first dc, 7 tr in next sc, [sc in 4th dc of next 7-dc group, 7 tr in next sc] across, ending with sc in last dc, **change**

**color** to medium forest green. Fasten off light golden brown.

**Row 8: Ch 6** (see *Pattern Notes*), tr in same st, [ch 4, 2 dc in 4th tr of next 7-tr group, ch 4, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next sc] across, ending with ch 4, 2 dc in 4th tr of next 7-tr group, ch 4, (tr, ch 2, tr) in last sc, turn.

**Row 9:** Sl st in first ch sp, ch 6, tr in same sp, [ch 5, **fp**tr around each of next 2 dc, ch 5, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next ch-2 sp] across, turn.

**Row 10:** Sl st in ch sp, ch 6, tr in same sp, [ch 5, **bp**tr around each of next 2 tr, ch 5, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next ch-2 sp] across, turn.

**Row 11:** Sl st in ch sp, ch 6, tr in same sp, [ch 7, **fp**tr around each of next 2 tr, ch 7, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next ch-2 sp] across, turn.

**Row 12:** Sl st in ch sp, ch 6, tr in same sp, [ch 8, **bp**tr around each of next 2 tr, ch 8, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next ch-2 sp] across, turn.

**Row 13:** Sl st in first ch sp, ch 6, tr in same sp, [ch 5, sc over ch sps of rows 11 and 12 tog, ch 5, **fp**tr around next tr, ch 3, **fp**tr around next tr, ch 5, sc over ch sp of rows 11 and 12 tog, ch 5, (tr, ch 2) twice and tr in next ch sp] across, ending with ch 5, **fp**tr around next tr, ch 3, **fp**tr around next tr, ch 5, sc over ch sp of rows 11 and 12 tog, ch 5, (tr, ch 2, tr) in last ch sp, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 14:** Join dark royal blue in first ch sp, ch 1, sc in same ch sp, \*ch 4, tr in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, tr) 7 times in same ch-3 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next ch-2 sp\*\*, ch 3, sc in next ch-2 sp, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 15:** Sk first sc and next ch-4 sp, join dark navy blue

in first tr, ch 5 (*counts as first dc, ch 2*), dc in next tr, [ch 2, dc in next tr] 6 times, \*ch 4, sc in next sc, ch 3, sc in next sc, ch 4, dc in first tr of 8-tr group, [ch 2, dc in next tr] 7 times, rep from \* across, leaving last ch-4 sp and last sc unworked, turn. Fasten off.

### FIRST PINEAPPLE

**Row 16:** Join dark rose with sc in first ch-2 sp of row 15, [ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp] 5 times, ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (*6 ch-4 sps*)

**Row 17:** [Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] 4 times, ch 2, dc in next ch-4 sp, turn. (*5 ch-4 sps*)

**Row 18:** [Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next ch-4 sp, turn. (*4 ch-4 sps*)

**Row 19:** [Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] twice, ch 2, dc in next ch-4 sp, turn. (*3 ch-4 sps*)

**Row 20:** Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, dc in next ch-4 sp, turn. (*2 ch-4 sps*)

**Row 21:** Ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, turn. Fasten off.

### REM 7 PINEAPPLES

**Row 16:** With finished Pineapple to the right, sk next ch-4 sp, sk next ch-3 sp and next ch-4 sp of row 15, join dark rose with sc in first ch-2 sp of Pineapple on row 15, [ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp] 5 times, ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (*6 ch-4 sps*)

**Rows 17–21:** Rep rows 17–21 of First Pineapple.

### EDGING

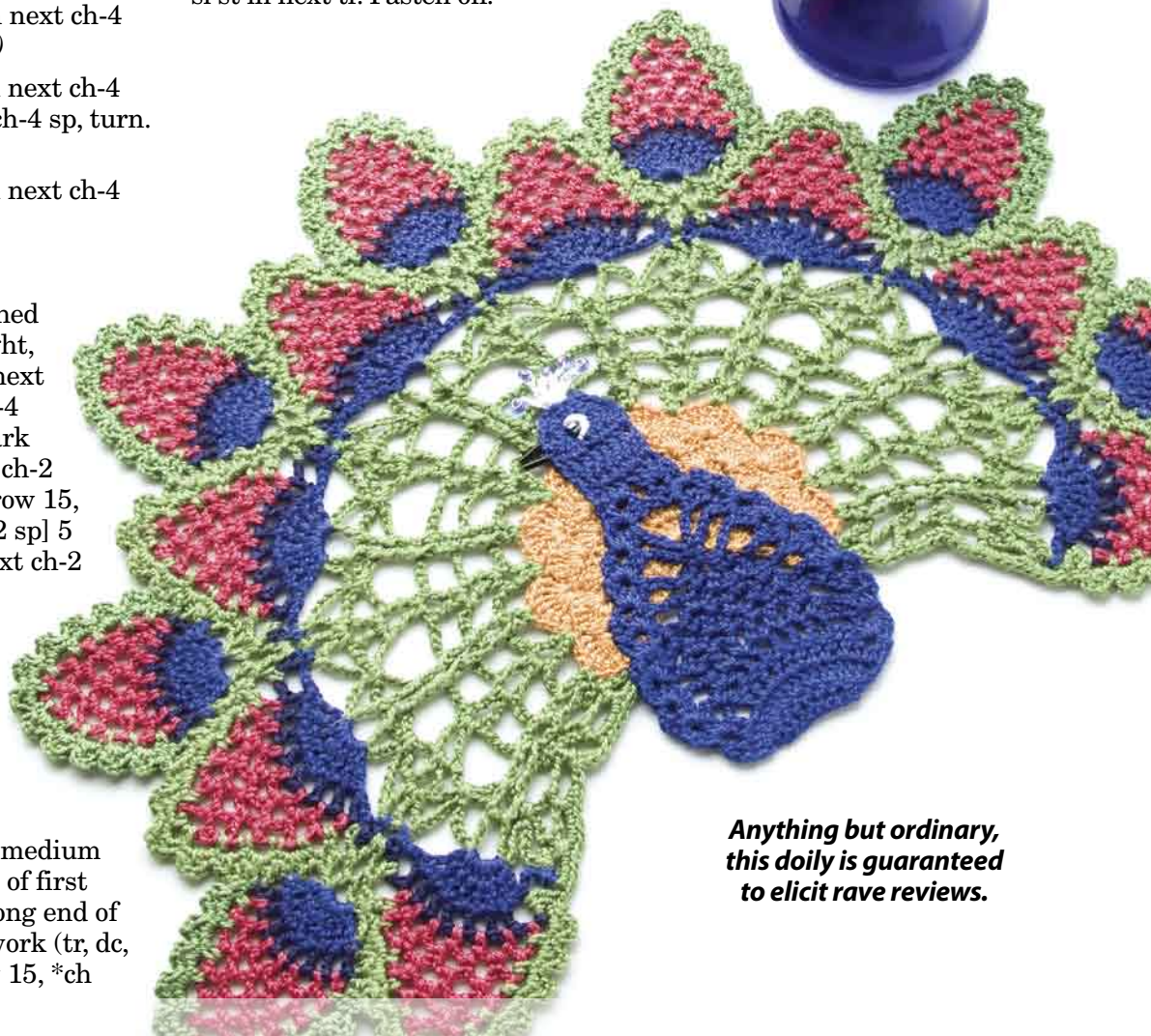
**Row 22 (RS):** Join medium forest green at base of first st on row 8, [4 sc along end of next row] 6 times, work (tr, dc, sc) along end of row 15, \*ch

3, sc in first ch sp of Pineapple, [ch 3, sc in next ch sp] 4 times, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in sp at tip of Pineapple, [ch 3, sc in next ch sp] 5 times\*\*, ch 3, dc in ch-4 sp of row 15, (dc, ch 3, dc) over ch-3 sps of both rows 14 and 15 tog, dc in ch-4 sp on row 15, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, ch 3, (sc, dc, tr) over end of row 15, [4 sc along end of next row] 6 times, sl st in base of last st on row 8. Fasten off.

**Row 23:** Join medium forest green with sl st to tr before First Pineapple, **scallop** (*see Special Stitches*) in each of next 11 ch-3 sps, \*sc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next ch-3 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next ch-3 sp, dc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next ch-3 sp, scallop in each of next 9 ch-3 sps, rep from \* 7 times, work scallop in rem 2 ch-3 sps, sl st in next tr. Fasten off.

### PINEAPPLE 2ND ROW

**Row 1:** Join dark royal blue with sl st in ch-2 sp of scallop just before ch-3 sp between Pineapples, tr in ch-3 sp, (ch 1, tr in same ch-3 sp) 7 times, sl st in next ch-2 sp of next scallop, turn. Fasten off.



**Anything but ordinary, this doily is guaranteed to elicit rave reviews.**

**Row 2:** Join dark navy blue in ch-2 sp of scallop just above where dark royal blue is joined, dc in first tr, [ch 2, dc in next tr] 7 times, sl st in ch-2 sp of next scallop, turn. Fasten off.

**Row 3:** Join dark rose with sc in first ch-1 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp] 5 times, ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp, turn. (6 ch-4 sps)

**Rows 4–8:** Rep rows 17–21 of First Pineapple.

[Rep rows 1–8 of Pineapple 2nd Row consecutively] 6 times.

### EDGING

**Row 9:** Join medium forest green with sl st to ch-2 sp of 9th scallop, ch 1, sc in same sp, dc in ch-2 sp of next scallop, sc in first ch sp of Pineapple, [ch 3, sc in next ch sp] 5 times, ch 3, sc in same ch sp as last sc, [ch 3, sc in next ch sp] 5 times, dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in ch-2 sp of next scallop, turn.

**Row 10:** Work scallop in each ch-3 sp, sl st to first sc of previous row, turn. Fasten off.

For row 9 of your next Pineapple, you will be skipping the next 3 scallops on row 23, then joining medium forest green with sl st in ch-2 sp of next scallop.

Rep rows 1–10 for rem 6 Pineapples.

### BODY

**Row 1:** With size 6 hook and dark royal blue, ch 10, dc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in each rem ch across, turn. (9 dc)

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in same st as beg ch-3, 2 dc in each dc across, turn. (18 dc)

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 7 times, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl st into ch-2 sp, **beg shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in same ch-2 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in first dc of 8-dc group, [ch 2, dc in next dc] 7 times, ch 3, **shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in next ch-2 sp, turn.

**Row 5:** Sl st into ch-2 sp of shell, beg shell in ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next ch-2 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp] 6 times, ch 4, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 6:** Sl st in ch-2 sp of shell, beg shell in ch-2 sp of shell, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] 5 times, ch 4, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 7:** Sl st in ch-2 sp of shell, beg shell in shell, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] 4 times, ch 4, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 8:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, beg shell in same ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] 3 times, ch 4, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 9:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, beg shell in same ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp] twice, ch 4, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 10:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, beg shell in same ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 11:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, beg shell in same ch-2 sp, ch 5, sk next ch-4 sp, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 5, shell in ch-2 sp of shell, turn.

**Row 12:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, beg shell in same ch-2 sp, ch 5, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next sc, ch 5, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, turn.

**Row 13:** Sl st in ch-2 sp of shell, beg shell in same ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, turn.

**Row 14:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [2 dc in next ch-2 sp] twice, dc in each of next 2 dc, turn. (8 dc)

**Rows 15 & 16:** Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

**Row 17:** Ch 3, dc in same st as beg ch-3, dc in each of next 6 dc, 2 dc in last dc, turn. (10 dc)

**Row 18:** Ch 3, **3-dc cl** (see *Special Stitches*) in next 3 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, 3-dc cl in next 3 dc, dc in last dc, turn. (6 sts)

**Row 19:** Ch 3, [**dc dec** in next 2 sts] twice, dc in next dc. Fasten off. (4 dc)


### HEAD CREST

**Row 1:** Thread 5 blue beads on white, and using size 10 hook, join with sl st in center st at top of head, ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 5, push up a bead, ch 1 over bead, ch 5, sc in same st on head] 5 times. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

For eye, thread embroidery needle with doubled strand of white cotton and make an 18-wrap bullion stitch near center of head about ¼ inch down from the top. Tack center of st down so it curves to the right. Sew 3mm black bead to inside curve of bullion stitch for eye.


For beak, sew tubular black beads to left side of head for beak leaving a little space between them so beak is pointed.

Sew Body to Tail using sewing needle and thread. Steam-press Peacock. 

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
