Poinsettia Doily

Designed by Jennifer Moir

SIZE:

14" across.

MATERIALS:

Size 10 crochet cotton thread — 300 yds. white, 225 yds. red, 175 yds. green and 75 yds. gold; No. 7 steel hook or hook size needed to obtain gauge.

GAUGE:

We are not responsible for lack of materials due to project not being worked to gauge. Gauge for this pattern: Rnds 1-6 = 3 1/2" across.

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, dc, tr.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

For beginning shell (beg shell), ch 4, (2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in same sp.

For shell, (3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in next ch

For decrease (dec), (yo, insert hook in next st, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) 4 times, yo, draw through all 5 lps on hook.

Doily

Rnd 1: With white, ch 10, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 21 sc in ring, join with sl st in fist sc. (21 sc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around, join. (42)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, (ch 6, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st) around to last 2 sts, skip last 2 sts; to join, ch 3, dc in first sc. (14 ch sps)

Rnds 4-5: Ch 1, sc around joining dc or tr, (ch 7, sc in next ch sp) around; to join, ch 3, tr in first sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc around joining tr, (ch 8, sc in next ch lp) around; to join, ch 4, tr in first sc.



Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc around joining tr, ch 8, (sc in next ch lp, ch 8) around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 8: SI st in first ch lp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 10 dc in same lp, 11 dc in each ch lp around, join with sI st in top of ch-3. (154 dc)

Rnd 9: Ch 6 (counts as first dc and ch-3 sp), skip next st, dc in next st, ch 3, skip next st, (dc in next st, ch 3, skip next 2 sts) around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-6. (52 dc, 52 ch sps)

Rnd 10: SI st in first ch sp, (ch 6, dc) in same sp, ch 3, skip next ch sp, *(dc, ch 3, dc) in next ch sp, ch 3, skip next ch sp; repeat from * around, join with sI st in third ch of ch-6.

Rnd 11: SI st in first ch sp, (ch 3, 4 dc) in same sp, ch 3, skip next ch sp, (5 dc in next ch sp, ch 3, skip next ch sp) around, join with sI st in top of ch-3, turn.

Rnd 12: SI st in first ch sp, ch 1, sc

in same sp, ch 7, (sc in next ch sp, ch 7) around, join with sl st in first sc, turn. (26 ch sps)

Rnd 13: SI st in first ch sp, ch 1, (sc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, sc) in same sp and in each ch sp around, join. (234 sts)

Rnd 14: SI st in next 2 sts, ch 7, skip next 3 sts, dc in next st, ch 4, skip next 4 sts, (dc in next st, ch 4, skip next 3 sts, dc in next st, ch 4, skip next 4 sts) around, join with sI st in third ch of ch-7. (52 ch sps)

Rnd 15: Ch 5, dc in next ch sp, ch 2, (dc in next st, ch 2, dc in next ch sp, ch 2) around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 16: SI st in first ch sp, (ch 5, dc) in same sp, ch 2, skip next ch sp, *(dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch sp, ch 2, skip next ch sp; repeat from * around, join with sI st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 17: SI st in first ch sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same sp, ch 2,

skip next ch sp, *(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp, ch 2, skip next ch sp; repeat from * around, join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rnd 18: SI st in next st, sI st in next ch sp, beg shell (see Special Stitches), ch 1, skip next ch sp, *shell (see Special Stitches) in next ch sp, ch 1, skip next ch sp; repeat from * around, join with sI st in top of ch-4. Fasten off. (52 shells)

First Poinsettia

Rnd 1: With gold, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 3, 13 dc in ring, join with sl st in top of ch-3. (14 dc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, skip next st, (sc in next st, ch 3, skip next st) around, join with sl st in first sc. (7 ch sps)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 4, (sc in next st, ch 4) around, join.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 5, (sc in next st, ch 5) around, join. Fasten off.

Small Petals

For first petal, working in rows, join red with sl st in any ch sp on rnd 2, *[ch 3, 4 dc in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec (see Special Stitches), turn, ch 3, sl st in top of dec, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 2]; for next petal, sl st in next ch sp; repeat from * 5 more times; repeat between [], join with sl st in first ch of first ch-3. Fasten off.

Large Petals

For first petal, working behind Small Petals, join red with sl st in any ch sp on rnd 3, (*ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 3, sl st in top of dec, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 3*; for next petal, sl st in next ch sp) 6 times; repeat between **, join with sl st in first ch of first ch-4. Fasten off.

Leaves

For first Leaf, working behind large

Petals, join green with sl st in any ch sp on rnd 4, *[ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, sc in ch sp of any shell on last rnd of Doily, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4]; for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, (ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, skip next shell on Doily, sc in next shell, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; *for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 3, sl st in top of dec, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; repeat from * 4 more times, join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

Next Poinsettia

Small and Large Petals Work same as First Poinsettia's Small and Large Petals.

Leaves

For first Leaf, working behind large Petals, join green with sl st in any ch sp on rnd 4, *[ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, skip next shell on Doily, sc in next shell on Doily, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4]; for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, (ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, skip next shell on Doily, sc in next shell, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; *for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 3, sl st in top of dec, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; repeat from * 3 more times, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp, turn, ch 2, dec,

turn, ch 1, sl st in ch sp on tip of corresponding Leaf on last Flower, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on this Flower, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4, join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

Repeat Next Poinsettia ten more times.

Last Poinsettia

Small and Large Petals Work same as First Poinsettia's Small and Large Petals.

Leaves

For first Leaf, working behind large Petals, join green with sl st in any ch sp on rnd 4, *[ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, skip next shell on Doily, sc in next shell on Doily, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4]; for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, skip next shell on Doily, sc in next shell, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp leaving remaining ch sps unworked, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, sc in ch sp at tip of corresponding Leaf on First Flower, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on Leaf, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; *for next petal, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 3, sl st in top of dec, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4; repeat from * 2 more times, sl st in next ch sp, ch 4, 4 tr in same sp, turn, ch 2, dec, turn, ch 1, sl st in ch sp on tip of corresponding Leaf on last Flower, ch 1, sl st in top of dec on this Flower, ch 3, sl st in end of next row, ch 3, sc in same ch sp on rnd 4, join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

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
