## SKILL LEVEL

## FINISHED SIZE

$521 / 2 \times 731 / 2$ inches

## MATERIALS

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $49 \mathrm{oz} /$ $2450 \mathrm{yds} / 1389 \mathrm{~g}$ white $23 \mathrm{oz} / 1150 \mathrm{yds} /$ 652 g lavender $14 \mathrm{oz} / 700 \mathrm{yds} / 397 \mathrm{~g}$ dark sage $11 \mathrm{oz} / 550 \mathrm{yds} / 312 \mathrm{~g}$ lilac 2 $\mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{yds} / 57 \mathrm{~g}$ bright yellow
- Sizes G/6/4mm and H/8/5mm
crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle


## GAUGE

Mum Motifs are 8 inches square. Fill-In Motifs are 4 inches square.

## NOTES

Using diagram as a guide, join motifs together as work progresses.
Use hook size G for flowers and leaves only. Remainder of motifs are crocheted with size H hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## FIRST MUM MOTIF

Rnd 1: With G hook and bright yellow, ch $4, \mathrm{sl}$ st in first ch to form a ring, ch $1,8 \mathrm{sc}$ in ring, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. ( 8 sc made)
Rnd 2: For front petals, working in front Ips (see Stitch Guide) for this rnd only, join lavender with sl st in any sc, [ch 7, sl st in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in each of next 4 chs, sl st in next sc of rnd 1] around, join with sl st in first sl st. (8 petals)
Rnd 3: For back petals, sl st in first back Ip (see Stitch Guide) of rnd 1, holding petals of rnd 2 forward and working in back lps only, rep rnd 2, ending with $s l$ st to bottom of first petal of this rnd. Fasten off. (8 petals)
Rnd 4: For leaf base, join dark sage with sl st in sl st between any 2 petals of rnd 3 , [ch 4, sl st between next 2 petals, sl st in sp between next 2 petals] around, ending with sl st in first sl st. ( $4 \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Rnd 5: For leaves, *sl st in next ch-4 sp, ch $1,3 \mathrm{sc}$ in same ch-4 sp, ch 1, turn, [sc in each of next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch}$ 1, turn] 3 times, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sc , sc in next sc, ch 1, turn, sc dec in next 2 sc , fasten off, join dark sage with sl st in same ch-4 sp, ch $1,3 \mathrm{sc}$ in same ch-4 sp, ch 1 , turn, [sc in each of next 3 sc , ch 1, turn] 3 times, sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, ch 1, turn, sc dec in next 2 sc , fasten off, rep from * in each of next 3 ch-4 sps. (8 leaves)
Rnd 6: For center, with G hook and bright yellow, ch 3, 7 hdc in third ch from hook, join with sl st in third ch of top of ch-3. Leaving a length of yarn, fasten off. Thread tapestry needle with rem length and sew the RS of center over rnd 1 of center of flower.
Rnd 7: With H hook, join white with sc around ch-4 sp of rnd 4 between any 2 leaves, holding all petals and leaves forward, ch $1, \mathrm{sc}$ in same sp , ch 3, [sc around ch-4 sp between next 2 petals, ch 3] around, join with sl st in first sc. (8 ch-3 sps)
Rnd 8: SI st in next ch sp, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2,3 dc) in same ch sp, 3 dc in next
ch sp, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-3 $\mathrm{sp}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-3 sp] around, join with sl st in top of ch-3. (36 dc)
Rnd 9: For anchor, sl st in ch-2 sp, holding petals forward and picking up a st in back of leaves as necessary to anchor them to rnd being worked, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in same sp, dc in each dc across, [(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in next ch-2 sp, dc in each dc across] around, join. (52 dc)
Rnd 10: SI st in corner ch-2 sp, (ch 3, dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same ch sp , dc in each dc across, [(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in next ch-2 sp, dc in each dc across] around, join. Fasten off. ( 68 dc )
Rnd 11: Join lilac with a sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in same ch sp, sk next 2 dc , [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc, sk next 2 dc] 5 times, *(sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in next ch sp, sk next 2 dc, [(sc, ch 3, sc ) in next dc, sk next 2 dc] 5 times, rep from * around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. (32 ch-3 sps)
Rnd 12: Join lavender with sl st in center ch-3 sp at any corner, ch 1, (sc, ch $3, \mathrm{sc})$ in same ch $\mathrm{sp},[(\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 3, \mathrm{sc})$ in next ch sp] around, join. Fasten off.
Rnd 13: Join white with sl st in ch-3 sp at any corner, ch 1, (sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in same ch sp, [(sc, ch 3, sc ) in next ch sp] 7 times, *[sc, (ch 3 , sc) 3 times] in next corner ch $s p$, [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch sp] 7 times, rep from * around, join. Fasten off. ( $40 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Rnd 14: Join white with sl st in center corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (sc, ch 5, sc) in same ch-3 sp, *[(sc, ch 3, sc) in next
ch-3 sp] 9 times**, (sc, ch $5, ~ s c) ~ i n ~_{\text {n }}$ next center corner ch-3 sp, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join. Fasten off.

## SECOND MUM MOTIF

 (make 59)Rnds 1-13: Rep rnds 1-13 of First Mum Motif.
Rnd 14: Rep rnd 14 of First Mum Motif, working at each center corner, (sc, ch 2 , sl st in adjacent ch-5 sp, ch 2, sc ) in same ch-3 sp and replacing the (sc, ch 3, sc) in each ch-3 sp with [sc in ch-3 sp, ch 1, sl st in corresponding lp on previously worked motif, ch 1, sc in same ch-3 sp] rep across side to be joined to previous motif, join. Fasten off.

## FILL-IN MOTIFS (make 20)

Rnd 1: With H hook and white, ch 4, sl st in first ch to form a ring, ch 2, 2 hdc in ring, ch 2, [3 hdc in ring, ch 2] 3 times, join with sl st in second ch of beg ch-2. Fasten off. (12 hdc made)
Rnd 2: Join lilac with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in same ch sp, sk next hdc, (sc, ch 3, sc ) in next hdc, sk next hdc, *(sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in next ch-2 sp, sk next hdc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next hdc, sk next hdc, rep from * around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. (16 ch-3 sps)
Rnd 3: Join lavender with sl st in center ch-3 sp of any corner, ch 1, (sc, ch $3, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in same ch-3 sp, *(sc, ch 3 , sc) in next ch-3 sp, rep from * around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join white with sl st in corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in same ch-3 sp, *[(sc, ch $3, s c)$ in next ch-3 sp] 3 times**, (sc, \{ch 3, sc\} 3 times) in next corner ch-3 sp, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join. Fasten off. (24 ch-3 sps)
Rnd 5: Join white with sl st in center corner ch-3 sp, rep rnd 3, replacing ( $s c$, ch $3, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next lp with ( sc , ch 1, sl st in corresponding ch sp on previously worked motif, ch $1, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next ch-3 sp on sides to be joined.

## TASSEL (make 18)

Cut 30 strands of white yarn each 12 inches long. Holding all strands tog at center, tie a separate length of yarn around strands at center. Fold strands in half at tied point and tie a 12-inch length of yarn around folded strands 1 1/4 inches below top. Blend tying ends in with strands of Tassel, trim ends.
Sew a Tassel to each of the nine bottom points on each end of Afghan. Trim ends even.


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
